

CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT PENALTY AND EXEMPTION POLICY

2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR

A 10% tuition deposit is required for each child. The required tuition and registration fee are non-refundable. Some amount may be refunded in certain conditions — specifically, a major/terminal illness or death in the immediate family (parent/child), job loss of a primary caregiver (parent), or termination of the child’s enrollment at Fairmont. Fairmont will also refund the deposit in some amount if a Financial Aid award is significantly reduced, provided the “process for not returning to Fairmont next year” has been completed prior to June 1, 2021.

Penalty Policy: Families who do not opt-out, and then break their contract by withdrawing after March 1, 2021 are contractually obligated to pay one month of tuition.

Exemption Policy: Fairmont will refund 100% of the advance deposit in the following circumstances:

- Fairmont exits a family from our community prior to the start of the school year
- A Financial Aid family who does not receive FA to their satisfaction will receive 100% of the advance deposit, provided they complete the “opt-out” process before June 1, 2021.
- In the event of major illness, job loss, or death of a primary caregiver in the family

Exemption Policy: Fairmont will refund 50% of the advance deposit in the following circumstance:

- The family provides written notice of their withdrawal for the 2021-22 school year between March 1 and May 1, 2021
