PREVENT COMMERCIAL PROPERTY DAMAGE FROM WATER DAMAGE AND MOULD

In the spring, one of the biggest threats to commercial properties is water damage. Snow transforms to rain, the frozen ground thaws, while excess water and condensation can collect around the foundation of your property. The risk of heavy rainfall during the season adds to the amount of water accumulation that can threaten your property.

The effects of flooding can cause interior and exterior property damage, hazardous mould and mildew growth and risks to business continuity depending on remediation required. THE DANGERS OF SPRING FLOODING:

- Leading into the spring melting season business properties are hardest hit by flooding in the lower levels of buildings where water seeps in through cracks in the foundation that may have developed over the winter
- With excess water flowing through sewers and drains, flooding is also a risk from sewer back-ups
- OBurst pipes and blocked sewers are common causes of water damage
- Heavy precipitation can result in leaks indoors from the roof, while melting ice and snow can create water accumulation in areas above and below ground
