Biophysical profile	Nitrogen, Liquid - skin application for cautey
Burn treatment / dressing	Older Adult Cognitive/Functional Ability Assessment
Cardiovascular Risk Assessment/Management	Older Adult Nutritional/Dental Assessment
Cast application	Pap Tests
Cast removal	Peak Flow Meter Testing, Use and Patient Teaching
Cerumen removal	Pelvic Exam
Clinical Breast Exam	Pessary Management
Colposcopy	Prostate Exam - Digital Rectal Exam
Cryotherapy	Pulmonary Function Testing - Spirometry, etc.
Cultures/Swabs	Rapid Influenza Screen
Cyst, removal of	Rapid Strep Testing
Development Screening for Children/Referrals	Rectal/Prostate Exam
Diabetic Foot Care	Remove foreign body - ear
Diagnostic interpretation of ECG	Remove foreign body - eye
Diagnostic interpretation of X-ray	Remove foreign body - other
Epistaxis Management	Screen/Manage Sleep Disorders
Exam of Eye for Foreign Body	Skin Biopsy
Excisional Biopsy	Skin tag removal
Eye wash	Splint strain/fracture
Family Violence Reporting/Management	STD & HIV Screening/Counseling
Fluorescein Dye	STD testing
Foreign Body Removal (any location)	Substance Use/Abuse Screening
Fracture Immobilization	Suture removal
Fundal height measurement (OB)	Therapeutic injections
Housing/Driving Concerns (patient functional assessment)	Throat Culture
Immunizations	Toe Nail (Ingrown) Removal
Incision and Drainage	Trigger Point Injection
Inhalation therapy	Tympanogram
Interpret Lab Studies	Use of Microscope and Slide Preparation
Joint Dislocation, management	Vaginal Culture
Joint injection/aspiration	Vaginal Wet Prep/Wet Mount
Laceration repair (Non operatively)	Vision Screening (other)
Laceration repair (suturing - If trained)	Vision screening (Snellen)
Long-term contraceptive management	Wart, destruction or removal
Long-term hormonal implantation	Well Woman Exam
Medication Reconciliation (assess patient resources)	Women Urinary and Gynecological Issues
Menopausal/Andropausal Symptom Management	Wood's lamp use
Microscopy	Wound Care/Management
Minor Lesion Removal	Wound Closure
Nail Avulsion	Wound Debridement
