Denver Rescue Mission	Provided training in de-escalation and aggressive behavior management to address injuries resulting from violent incidents in a homeless shelter.
Family Health West*	Purchased two mechanical lifts for residents/patients to address lifting injuries in a community health setting.
Family Health West*	Purchased anti-slip tape and plates as well as anti-slip shoes for staff to address slips, trips and falls.
Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver	Purchased pallet jacks, hand trucks, dollies and moving carts to address strain and other injuries related to moving appliances and other heavy items.

Alpine Autism Center	Prevention of aggressive behavior injuries (struck-by, bites) with specialty padding and installation of a door in an existing de-escalation padded/secured room.
Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc.	Prevention of musculoskeletal disorders with equipment such as pallet lifts, height adjustable food prep tables, anti-fatigue mats, mobile food racks, and sliding cargo truck bed system for vans.
Envision	Prevention of musculoskeletal disorders with equipment such as; height adjustable changing table for special needs clients, powered-height adjustable table for transfers, and slide transfer boards.
Goodwill of Colorado	Prevention of falls, struck-by/caught-in injuries with portable, steel barricade gates with casters.
Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver	Prevention of musculoskeletal disorders with equipment such as: Electric powered pallet jacks for moving pallets at Habitat for Humanity ReStores.
MaxFund Animal Adoption and Rehabilitation Center	Prevention of cat bites and scratches using a cat shield when administering meds, shots, etc.
Resource Central	Prevention of musculoskeletal disorders with equipment such as: Electric powered pallet jacks for moving pallets, appliance dollies, and panel carts.
Roundup Fellowship	Prevention of aggressive behavior injuries (struck-by, bites) with QBS advanced Safety Cares de-escalation training and blocking pads.
Special Kids Special Families	Prevention of slips/falls on snow and ice with a salt spreader and salt/deicer.
STRIVE Prep	Prevention of slips/trips/fall on stairways and ramps throughout campus using Form-a-Tread traction kits.
Via Mobility Services	Prevention of slips/trips/falls in parking lots and sidewalks with an ATV equipped with a plow and a salt spreader.
YMCA of the Rockies	Prevention of slips/falls on snow and ice with Stabilizers traction control, slip-on devices for footwear.
