Low-cost cloud file storage and data protection

Executive Overview

Wasabi is fundamentally transforming cloud storage with hot cloud storage—the corporate world's most affordable cloud storage solution. While primarily used by businesses, many consumers use Wasabi hot cloud storage to store photos, videos and documents, or to back up their desktops.

This tech brief provides a short overview of Wasabi and explains some of the differences between Wasabi hot cloud storage and popular personal cloud storage products like Dropbox, Google Drive and Microsoft OneDrive, as well as personal backup products like Carbonite, Mozy and Backblaze. It will help you determine if Wasabi hot cloud storage is right for you.

Introducing Wasabi Hot Cloud Storage

Wasabi's mission is to make cloud storage a simple, open-standard commodity and utility, just like electricity. Wasabi hot cloud storage is cost-effective, fast and reliable cloud storage—for any purpose.

Wasabi is significantly less expensive and significantly faster than other corporate cloud storage services like Amazon Simple Storage Service (S3), Google Cloud Platform and Microsoft Azure. In fact, Wasabi hot cloud storage is so inexpensive, many individuals and small businesses use it as well. You can use Wasabi to protect your data and to store files in the cloud—conveniently and reliably. Back up your PC or Mac, or save photos, videos or documents—quickly and securely.

With Wasabi, you can take full advantage of the same fast and dependable cloud storage service that large corporations rely on, and depending on your use, Wasabi could cost less than Dropbox or other consumer-focused storage services.

Wasabi Hot Cloud Storage is Affordable and Simple

Wasabi hot cloud storage costs just \$.0069/GB/month (with a minimum 1 TB requirement). You can store one terabyte of data on Wasabi for \$6.99 per month, compared to \$9.99 per month for Dropbox and Google Drive, and \$6.99 per month for OneDrive. Better still, with Wasabi you only pay for the incremental storage you actually use.


With many of the consumer services, if you need 11 TB (for example), you are forced to purchase a 20 TB tier rather than the capacity you actually need.

Wasabi Hot Cloud Storage Client for Mac & Windows

Wasabi is a little bit different than most consumer cloud storage services. We offer a Mac and Windows client that makes Wasabi hot cloud storage appear as an external drive on your desktop—your own personal storage cloud. With the Wasabi Hot Cloud Storage Client you can move files in and out of the cloud the same way you would with a local drive, with drag-and-drop simplicity and convenience.



Choose from a Wide Range of Storage Management and Backup Tools

Unlike some consumer products, the Wasabi Hot Cloud Storage Client is not intended for easily sharing files with friends and family, and it does not include automated backup and recovery functionality. Instead Wasabi works with a variety of third-party storage management, file sharing and desktop backup solutions.

Our partnership approach is consistent with other corporate cloud storage solutions like Amazon S3. Wasabi's Performance and Certification Team (PACT) has certified dozens of free and commercial tools. And we're constantly expanding our partner ecosystem.

You can use Wasabi with third-party applications to back up your home or small-business computer—quickly, securely and reliably. In some cases Wasabi is less expensive than personal cloud backup services like Carbonite, Mozy or Backblaze, which cost \$60 a year or more. Wasabi works with many PC and Mac backup tools including CloudBerry, qBackup and Arq.

And unlike most consumer storage services that come with dedicated desktop and mobile clients, Wasabi is designed to be used with third-party file management and backup applications.
