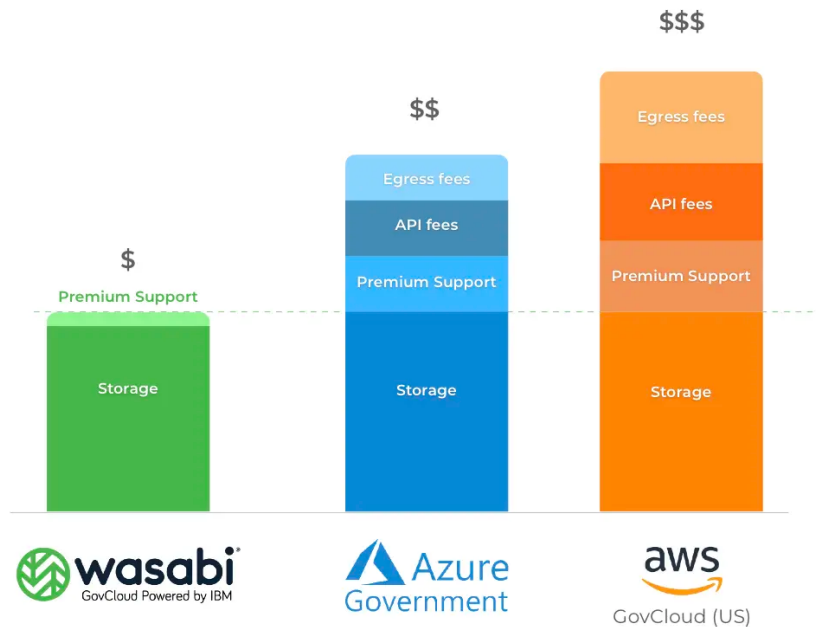

- › State and local government, education, and treasury departments

Secure long-term archives for records, logs, and evidence that must be retained for years or decades, with predictable costs and reliable access for audits, investigations, and historical analysis.

Cloud Tiering

Wasabi GovCloud Powered by IBM is recognized industry-wide as the lower-cost alternative for tiering existing data and automatically offloading colder data to the cloud, while keeping it accessible and easing pressure on constrained on-prem or primary cloud environments.
