A COST-EFFECTIVE SOLUTION THAT ELIMINATES SOFTWARE UPDATE RISKS

Lapland University of Applied Sciences is aiming high and looking to benefit from paperless financial administration. The process is based on the organization's experience and commitment to continuous development, and the solution is provided by Basware's cloud-based Purchase-to-Pay service which provides transparency and automation.

In 2014, the departments of two municipally-owned universities of applied sciences were merged to form Lapland University of Applied Sciences. This also had major impacts on their financial administration. From the start, it was clear that financial administration should support the institution's core activities. In practice, the change meant that the entire financial management system of the new university of applied sciences needed to be set up in six months.

Before the merger, two different systems were used for handling purchase invoices: CGI's Rondo and Basware Invoice Processing. The new organization decided to adopt one solution that would be able to adapt to changing needs.

The fact that the system is a new-generation solution that will be developed long into the future influenced the decision.

CHALLENGING SITUATIONS REQUIRE AND BUILD TRUST

The project schedule was challenging. All the systems needed by financial administration had to be in production within six months. Due to the tight schedule, the first stage of the project included adopting Basware Invoice Automation, Basware Finance Performance Management, Basware Banking and Basware Finance.

Basware's consultants were aware of the goal and the schedule, and ensured that the project was carried out accordingly. of the software. All the new features and improvements of the Basware solution will be available to us as soon as they are published. A cloud-based solution is cost-effective, eliminates risks and costs related to software updates and does not tie up our staff resources," Jänkälä says.

The University of Applied Sciences has been particularly happy with the versatile account assignment features of the new solution. Importing account assignments directly from Microsoft Excel saves them a considerable amount of time. Users can also search for invoices using versatile search functions, and separate reporting software is not needed. The detailed invoice history and the fact that the user interface can be modified in various ways both improve user friendliness. Admin users have enjoyed the improvements in transferring invoices to the ERP system and then for payment, which has freed up time for other tasks. "The Basware Purchase-to-Pav solution is more pleasant to use than the previous solutions," Sinikka Jänkälä and the accounts payable team confirm.

SCANNING AND PAPER INVOICES MAKE WAY FOR E-INVOICES

"According to our goal, 90% of all received invoices should be e-invoices," Jänkälä says. The University of Applied Sciences is very close to achieving this goal, as 87% of its received invoices are now e-invoices.

The supplier activation service helps Lapland University of Applied Sciences in proactively contacting suppliers and informing them of the goal concerning e-invoicing. This provides financial administration staff with more time for other tasks.

MAKING THE MOST OF THE PROCUREMENT PROCESS

"The next step will be developing our procurement process," Jänkälä says. The development of the procurement process is a joint effort where expertise in both finance and procurement are needed, and the project will be led by the director of finance and the director

of administration at the University of Applied Sciences. One of the important aspects of procurement processes is determining who has the right to make purchases. Large volumes and risk points also need to be centralized. The systematic use of the Basware Purchase-to-Pay service will ensure transparency and control.

"The use of a procurement system ensures that the process will function correctly and as desired," Sinikka Jänkälä emphasizes. "The purpose of this is to examine the entire process through a transparent approach without concealing anything. Cost-awareness is a result of acting openly and monitoring financial administration as a whole," Jänkälä adds.

MANAGING DISTANCE

Lapland University of Applied Sciences has an independent financial administration department that operates in two different locations. Distance management is one of the core competences of the educational institution, and it is applied throughout the organization. Lapland University of Applied Sciences provides a good example of how an organization can succeed thanks to the existing conditions, not despite them. Others can also
