

## INSTALLING THE TWIST LOCK CARRIER To the RX Adaptor\*







Not all Goggles are compatible with RX Carriers. Please verify that your RX carrier is compatible with your Wiley X goggles.





INSERTING GOGGLE LENS

GOGGLE GASKET



REMOVE / ATTACH GOGGLE STRAP

ATTACHING THE RX ADAPTOR



Separate the frame from the top of the lens. Grab exposed lens and pull the lens from the goggle frame.

First seat the lens into the frame at nose piece, then seat the outer edges. Finish by seating the top of the lens fully into the goggle frame. The included removable / replaceable comfort gasket is secured by four hooks, 3 of which are indicated in the graphic above. Utilization of the gasket is especially recommended for individuals requiring corrective (Rx) lenses.

Remove or attach the goggle strap by positioning the strap perpendicular to the frame as pictured above. The Rx Adaptor post is pressed into the goggle frame as shown.
