Brunschwig & Fils' Le Parnasse collection evokes the romantic spirit of its poetic origin; a showcase of the most famous poets of the 19th century. Traditional yet whimsical patterns, created with a loose artistic hand and soft subtle colorations, honor this French literary movement. Elegant embroideries, finely detailed prints, striated weaves, delicate sheers and a versatile velvet tell a thoughtful story that celebrates this moment in time.

VERRIERES PRINT

Originally a block print designed by Jacques de Luze in Switzerland in 1810, this iconic L'Indienne floral was made famous by its use in poet Louise de Vilmorin's country chateau outside Paris. Verrieres Print was first introduced into the Brunschwig library in 1960 and is one of the longest-running patterns in Brunschwig & Fils' history.

GAUTIER PRINT

First introduced as Panjore, a Brunschwig & Fils documentary cotton chintz print and wallpaper in the 1960s, this classic pattern has been updated by modifying the original layout and employing a new print and embroidery quality. Gautier is hand-screen printed with accents of handguided embroidery to accentuate various motifs.

GWENDOLINE PRINT

Gwendoline Print is taken from an 18th century document found in the Brunschwig & Fils archives. Printed in France on a cotton-linen union ground cloth, Gwendoline Print pays tribute to the poetic theme by showcasing an ethereal palette.
