Automating logistics processes is proven to reduce the time spent booking or tendering multi-mode shipments on ocean, air, truck and rail carriers by 50% or more. It also improves customer service performance and maintains compliance with shipping regulations. However, transportation execution is complicated by the multi-party, multi-tier efforts requiring interaction between many partners, each of which has preferred channels for collaboration. Bookings streamlines the booking process with a single system to execute requests with multi-mode transportation providers. Shippers save time, eliminate redundant data entry and streamline operations by accessing one portal for all shipments. Carriers can also use the application to receive and confirm bookings from the largest network of shippers. This multi-lateral collaboration platform gives carriers, shippers and other providers a robust digital solution for shipment booking collaboration.

Simplified Bookings Using a Single Portal

Having selected the best rate and schedule, shippers can book or tender directly with carriers across multiple legs and transport modes with a single connection. They can create requests from scratch or from an existing booking, or utilize templates to quickly and accurately initiate new bookings. The system electronically transmits carrier booking requests and returns a carrier confirmation. The shipment details are automatically screened against published dual-use goods, restricted or sanctioned parties and destination controls lists to ensure compliance.

Electronic Sharing of Critical Documents and Instructions

Regardless of the format of unique shipping instructions, international laws detail the required data that must be communicated to all relevant parties regarding transported goods. Bookings enables shippers to submit required data to carriers through multiple electronic formats, ensuring cargo will be on-boarded without delay. It also enables companies to digitize their data sharing and shift away from manual processes — improving speed, accuracy and compliance.

The Advantage of an Existing Network

E2open's platform provides existing, re-usable connectivity to the industry's largest carrier community, including 2,600 rail and truck carriers, 750 ocean and 200 air freight carriers, 14,000 freight forwarders and many notable logistics service providers. More than 40 million TEUs are moved annually on the platform, representing over onequarter of global ocean trade. These existing connections reduce the need to invest time and money to integrate with new carriers for additional transport modes or regions.

Compliance With SOLAS Regulations

The International Maritime Organisation's amended Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) is widely considered the most important treaty governing the safety of merchant ships. It requires that shippers report cargo gross mass data — referred to as Verified Gross Mass (VGM) — to carriers. As part of this application, shippers can easily transmit VGM data to carriers via integration with external weight providers and terminal weigh stations. They then automatically receive confirmation from the carrier, ensuring compliance while creating a reliable audit trail.





Full Tracking and Visibility

With integration to Logistics Visibility, shippers achieve greater ability to track shipments in transit, monitor milestone events, accurately predict arrival times and take corrective actions when necessary. This not only improves efficiency but also reduces risk and makes companies more agile by integrating Logistics Visibility.
