Key Information

Monolith can heighten your space in a variety of ways. Consider these questions as you design your layout.

If shop drawings are required for your project, please follow steps 1 - 2.

Quick Ship

If you're looking to expedite your project, this product is available as Turf Quick Ship!

Using Quick Ship, our standard lead time for shop drawings is eliminated allowing the project to move directly into production.


Please note, installation and layout drawings are not included in this process.

Turf recommends an additional 10-15% additional panels to cover overage / attic stock.

Panel Details

Design

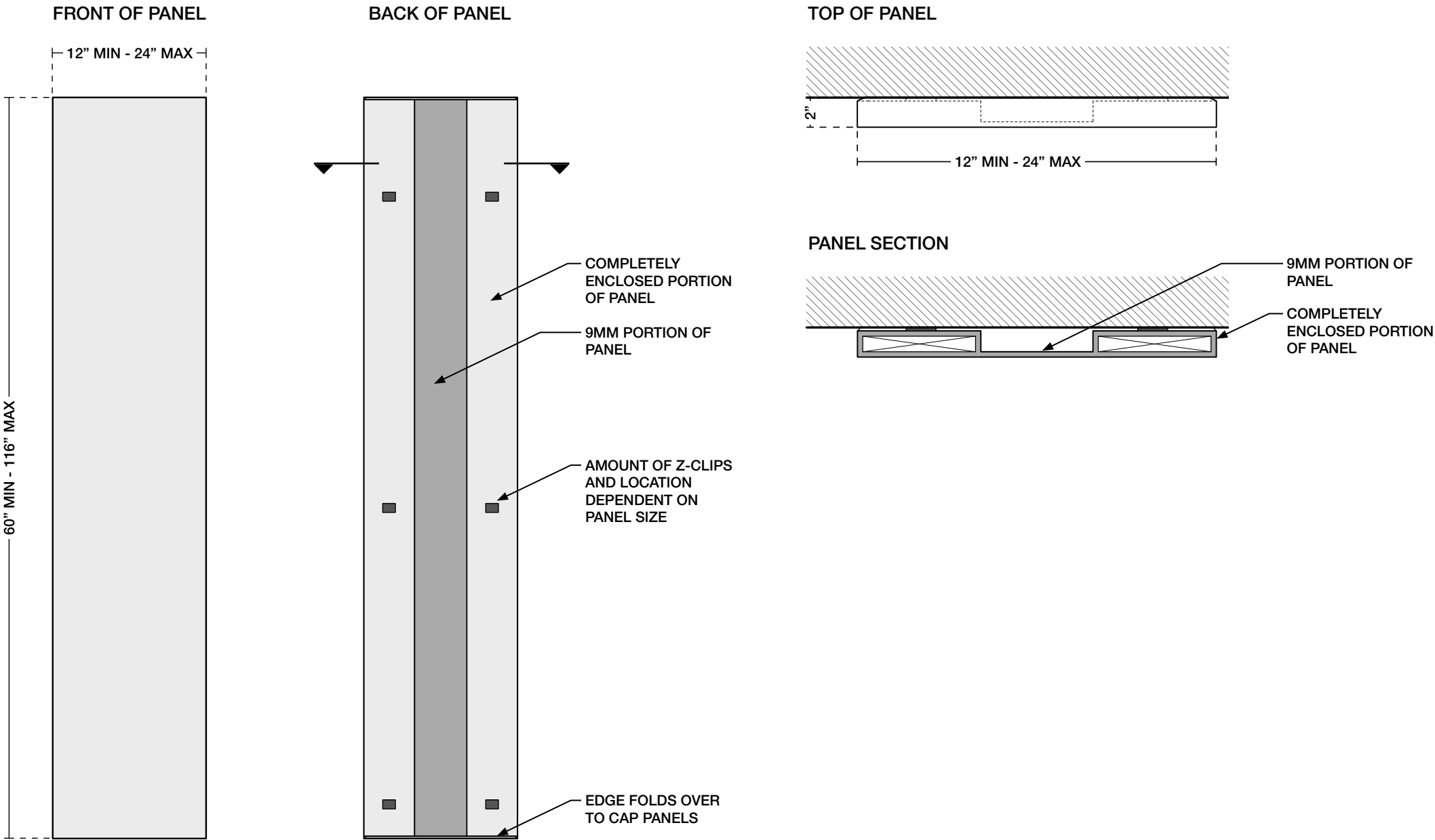
Monolith can cover existing walls, elevating spaces and balancing sound. Panels are designed for wall use only. Stone Textures and Graphic Prints are both available.

Panel Depth

Panels have a flat face on the panel's front and are 2" deep.

There are portions of the panel that are completely enclosed and portions only as thick as the material.

Stone Layout Type - Book Match

Description

Book matching allows the texture to flow from panel to panel & mirror at any edge along the layout. Panels can be book matched along vertical and horizontal axes, creating a seamless pattern.

Book Match Considerations

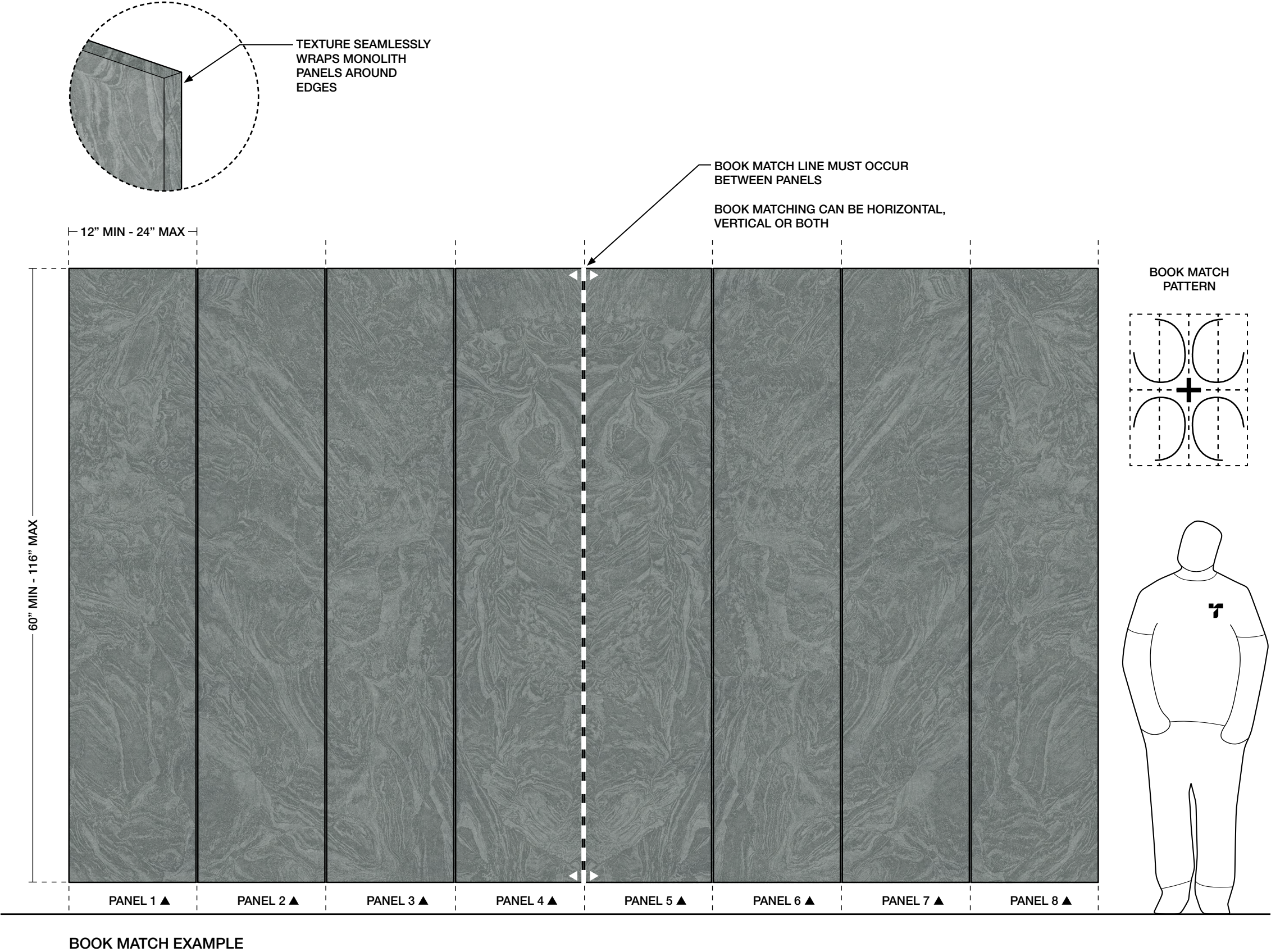
The book match line must occur between panels, and can be placed at any panel edge along the wall.

Monolith can be book matched in the middle of your layout, or anywhere in between to create something unique.

Stone Layout Type - Slip Match

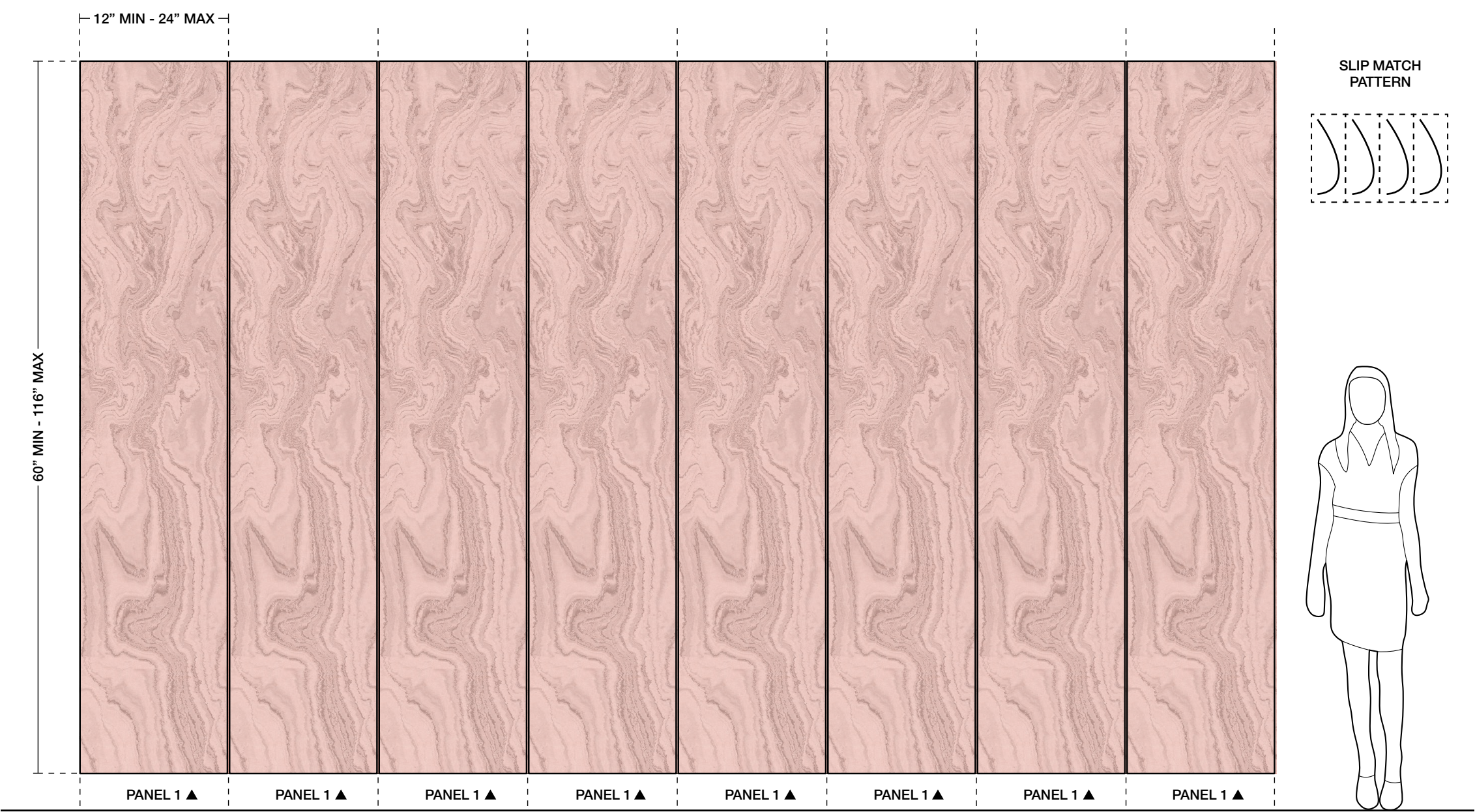
Description

Slip matching creates a stamped look by using a single panel in the same orientation.

Stone Layout Type - Reverse Slip Match

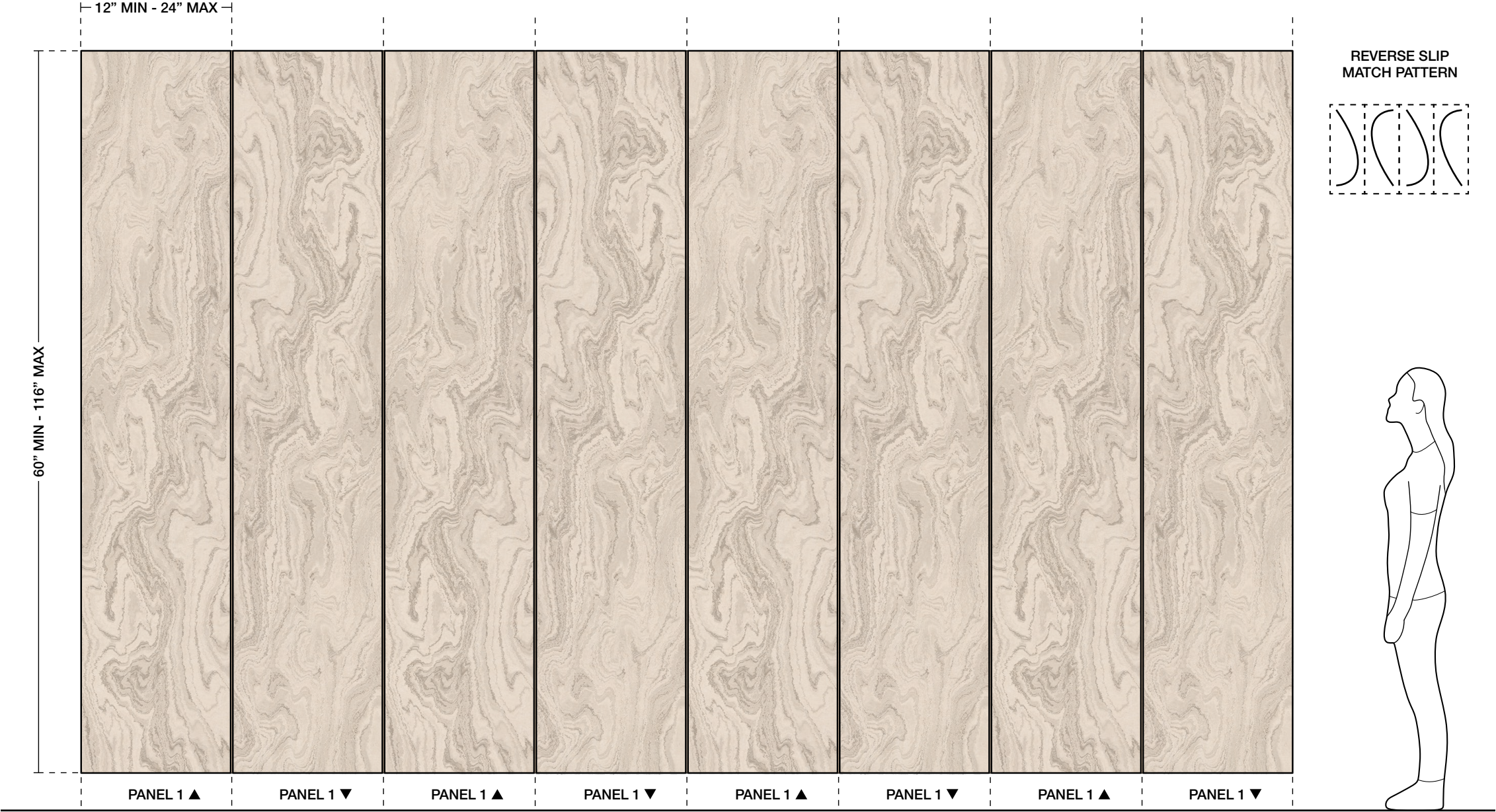
Description

Reverse slip matching creates an alternating stamped look by reversing the orientation of a single panel.

Stone Layout Type - Aesthetic Match

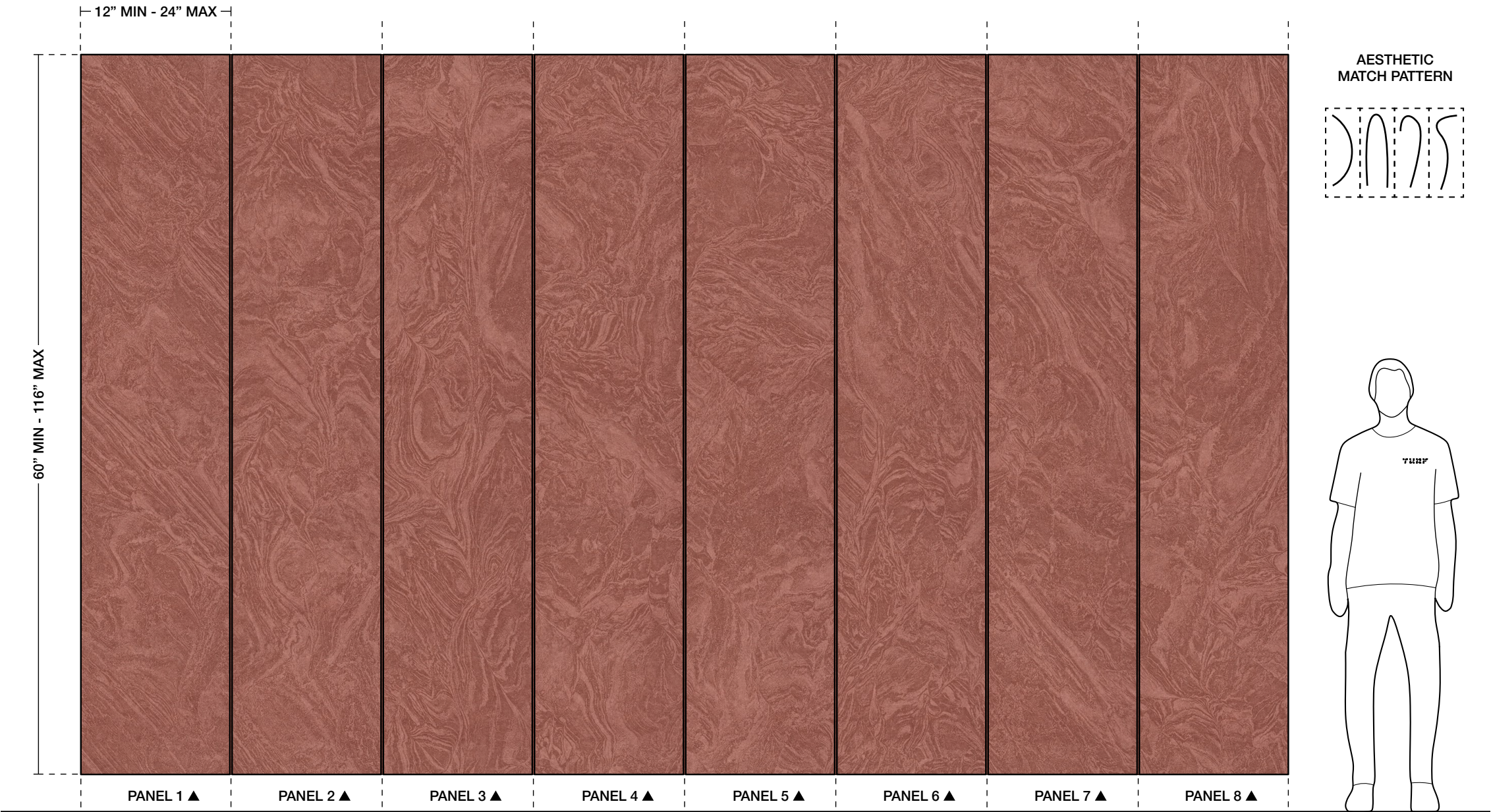

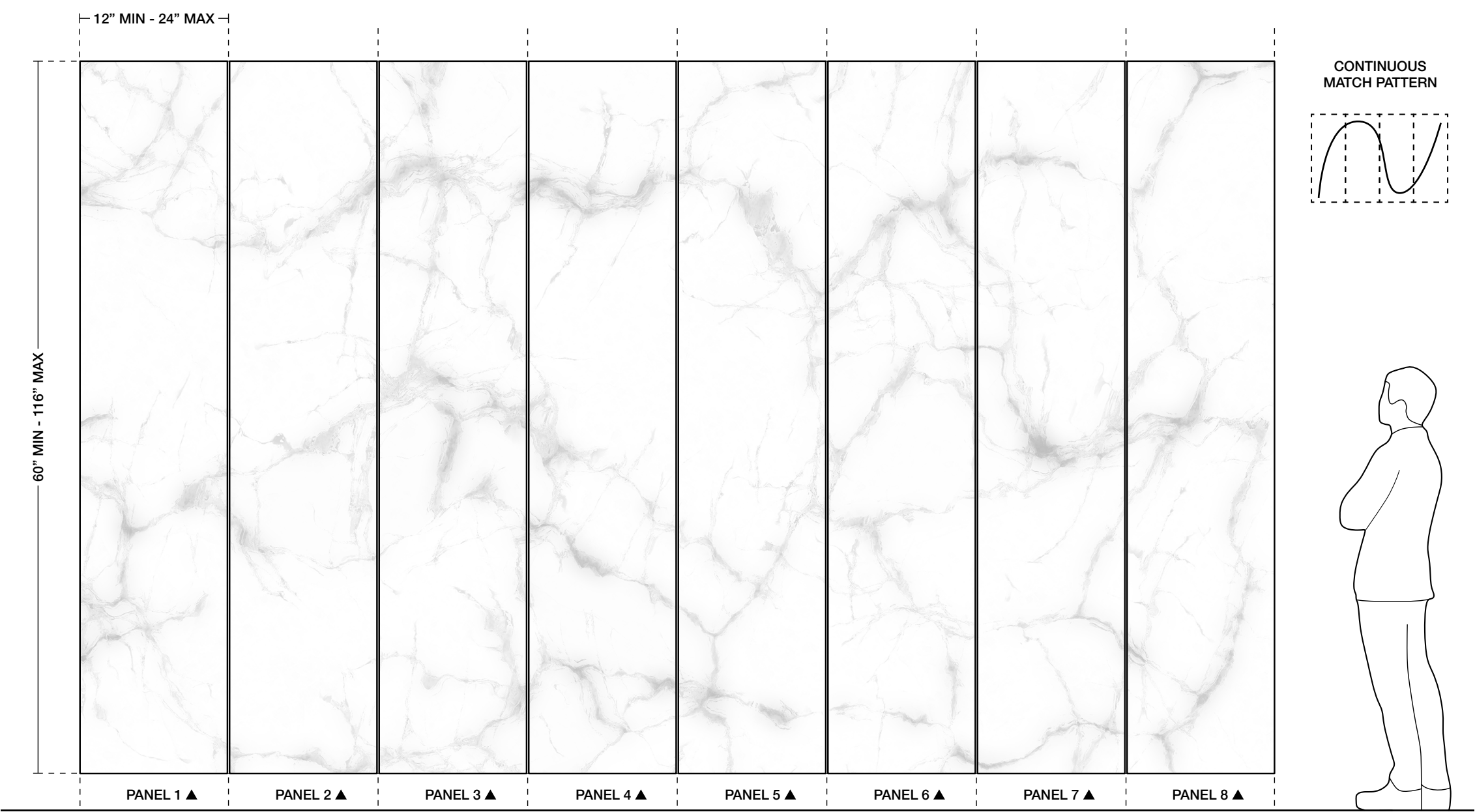

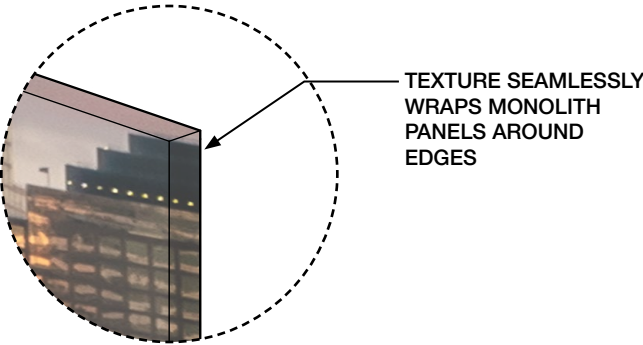
Layout Type - Graphic Print

Availability

Please note, Graphic Print will be available Summer 2024.

Artwork Specifications

Print ready artwork must be provided in a vector file format (either AI or EPS) or high-resolution (300dpi) raster file. The files should be in a CMYK format.



Colors must be specified in CMYK, Pantone Uncoated, or by physical sample.

If the artwork is printed on a colored substrate, details will need to be outlined. Keep in mind that the print on each panel will wrap around the edge.

Proportion

To avoid cropping, please provide artwork with matching proportions to your desired space.

Strike Offs

An 18"W x 18"L strike off will be provided for client approval.

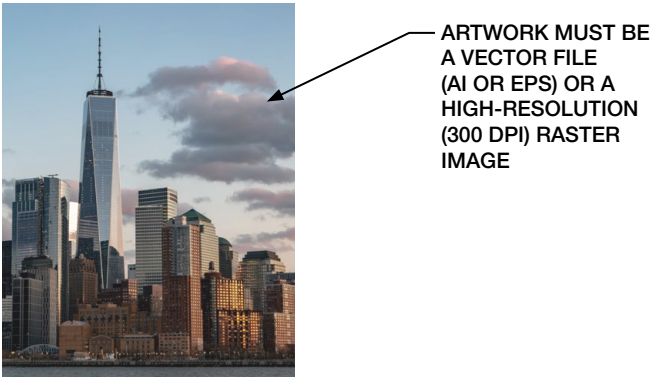

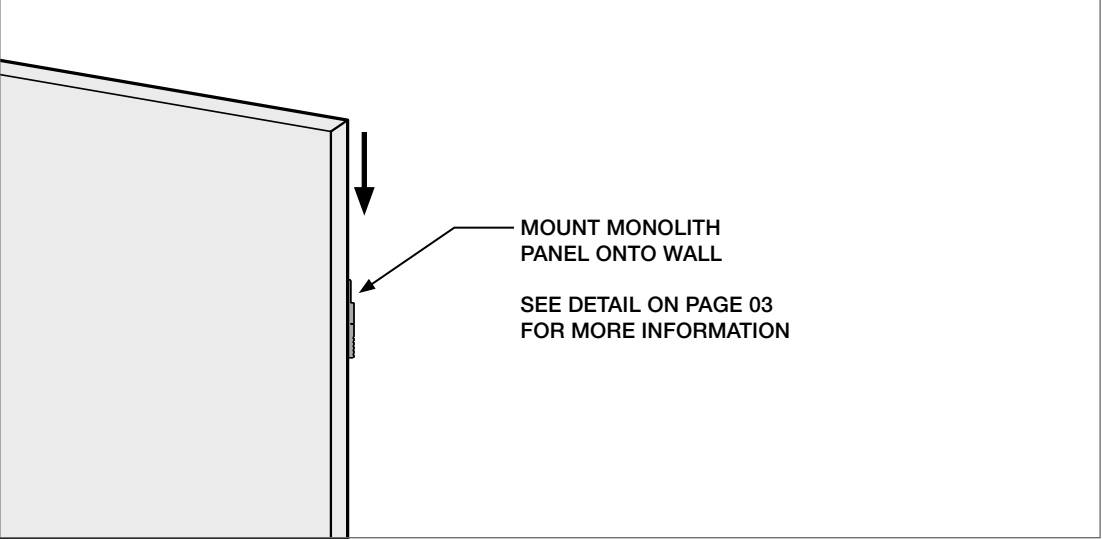
2 - USE STORY POLE TO SET LASER LINE



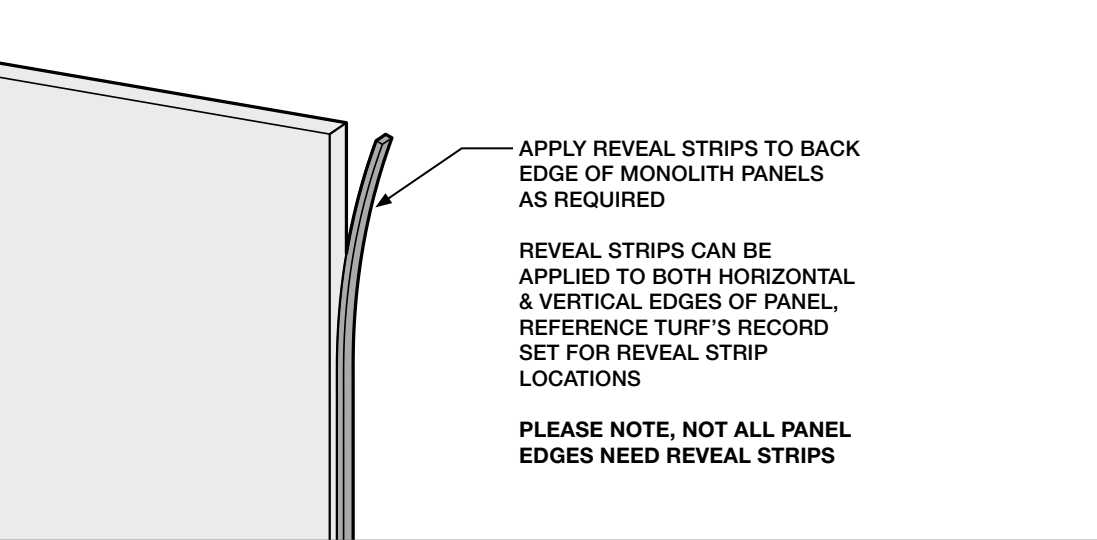
3 - ATTACH Z-BAR TO WALL



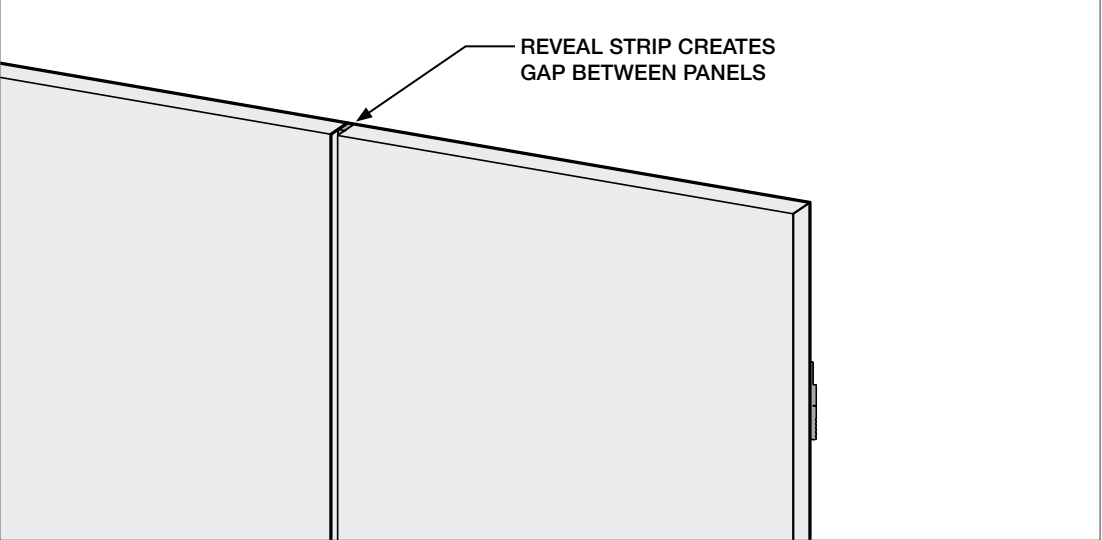

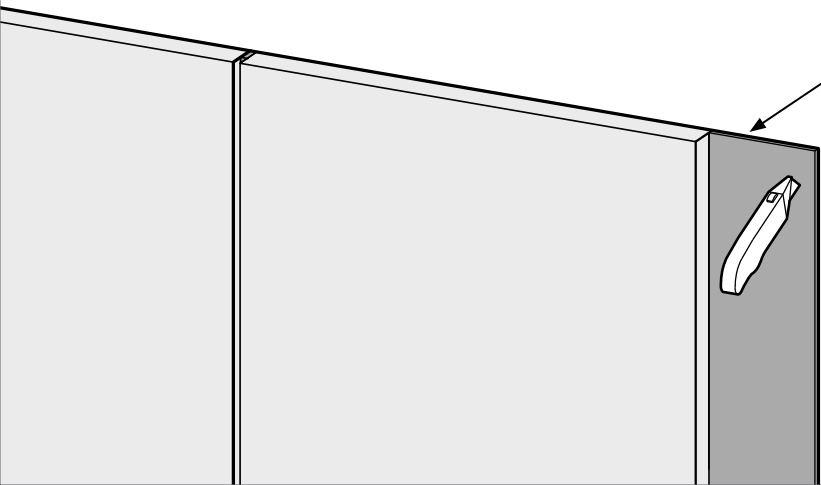
1 - TRIM PANEL HORIZONTALLY AS REQUIRED

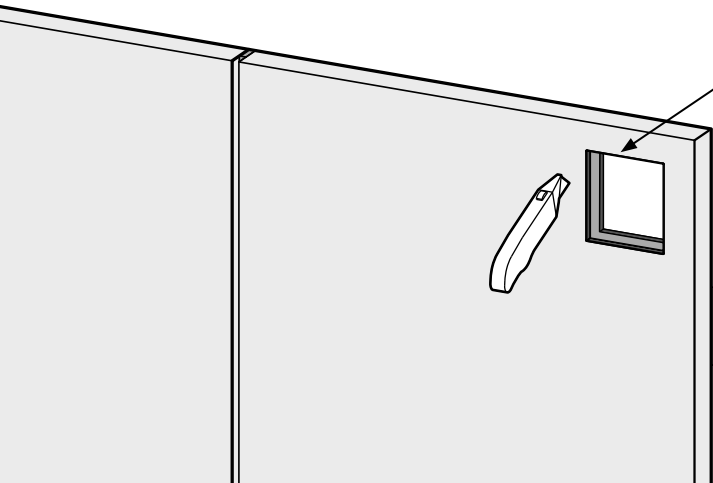

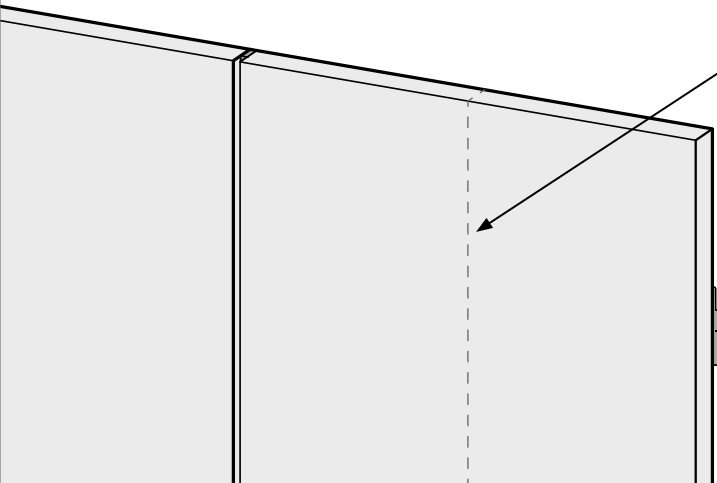
3 - CUTTING HOLES FOR FIXTURES & EQUIPMENT

Introducing Hues, our new 9mm color palette designed for the senses.

The 9mm PET felt board is used as our primary construction material. Select one of our coordinating neutrals to blend in, or go for a contrasting element with one of our hues.

The process used to create PET felt often results in a heathered effect where multiple tones are present. Slight variations in color should be expected when using this sustainable material.
