The Fox Performing Arts Center opened in 1929 as a cinema/vaudeville theater house featuring a Spanish Colonial Revival architectural style. Well-known performers including Bing Crosby and Judy Garland performed here. The theater became a popular location for motion picture previews and was also the site of the first public screening of "Gone with the Wind". The Fox now boasts a 1,600 seat state-of-the-art performing arts theater that captures the original grandeur of the 1929 building, with updated amenities.
