1. What do I want attendees to remember – what are the objectives?

Small meetings are trending for a reason. According to a survey conducted by MeetingBooster, small meetings are 50% more productive than larger meetings. They're more effective for hands-on breakout sessions, problem solving/strategizing and ensuring more voices are heard. They're also a great way to get out of the usual workspaces (at home or in cubicles) for training, celebrating, bonding and brainstorming.

What technology do I need to ensure a seamless small meeting?



Does your speaker have a multimedia presentation?

Content should be clear and visible to all attendees, including those who may be participating virtually or have vision impairments. Ensuring displays are shown at a high resolution with clear and legible visuals regardless of lighting or placement in the room is essential for any successful event. Additional screens can guarantee remote attendees are fully seen.



Will the speaker and the computer audio be clear enough for everyone to hear?

It's a crucial component to any meeting. Having microphones for the speaker and tabletop microphones for participants can ensure that all voices are heard and everyone can engage in the presentation. Appropriate amplification for the room size is also important. Licensed commercial music can help set the mood.


