Variety	Zone*	Flower Color	Bloom Time**	Recommended Finished Pot Sizes	Description
Lavandula angustifolia					
'Essence Purple'	5-9	Bright Purple	May-July	6"-12"	Uniform, dense branching with green, aromatic foliage. Blooms with long-lasting bright purple flowers.
'Hidcote Blue'	5-8	Royal Purple	May-July	4"-10"	Long-lasting fragrance and rich purple flowers are held above a tidy mound of grey-green foliage.
Lavenize® 'Silver Forever'	5-9	Dark Purple	May-August	5"-12"	Compact, tidy and symmetrical, this plant with silver-hued foliage is accented with masses of deep purple flowers.
'SuperBlue'	5-8	Bright Purple	May-August	5"-10"	Compact growth with vibrant, fragrant blooms on short flower stems, showing a mass of color. A versatile garden plant.
Lavandula hybrids					
'Meerlo'	9-10	Pale Violet-Blue	June-August	6"-12"	Soft, fragrant grey-green foliage has gently serrated yellow to cream-colored margins. Pale blue flowers are borne on long stems, but the bright accent from the foliage is the main attraction.
'Phenomenal'	5-9	Violet-Purple	June-August	6"-12"	Violet-hued flowers are borne on tall stems above a compact mound of silver-green foliage.
Lavandula stoechas & pedunculata					
'Anouk Dark Purple'	7-9	Dark Purple	April-June	4"-10"	Robust lavender, rounded and densely branched, with grey-green leaves. Long-lasting, fragrant, dark purple flowers are massed on top of the foliage.
'Anouk Deep Rose'	7-9	Burgundy-Purple	April-June	4"-10"	Compact growth habit with silvery-green foliage set off the dark purple flowers with rich rose-tone bracts above.
'Anouk Purple Crown'	7-9	Purple	April-June	6"-12"	Full, densely branched lavender with grey-green foliage. Dark purple flowers cover the flower spike, topped with royal purple bracts. The color lasts into the summer, with additional flushes of flowers.
'Anouk Purple Flare'	7-9	Indigo-Purple	April-June	6"-12"	Compact, densely branched with blue-grey foliage. Flower spikes are topped with distinctly shaped, indigo-colored bracts.
'Anouk Twilight'	7-9	Magenta-Purple	April-June	6"-10"	Symmetrical, upright appearance, with showy magenta-purple flowers displayed above the fragrant grey-green foliage.
Lavinnova® 'Intense Purple'	7-9	Purple	April-July	5"-12"	Tidy, broadly-rounded appearance. Broad, pale-green leaves contrast with the elegant, rich purple flowers.
Lavinnova® 'The Princess'	7-10	Bright Pink	April-May	5"-10"	The neat, compact and upright form is covered by fragrant, intense pink flowers, contrasting with the aromatic grey foliage.
'Primavera'	7-9	Burgundy-Purple	February-December	4"-10"	Rich green foliage lifts large spikes of burgundy-toned purple flowers and bracts for display at almost any time of year, depending on the growing location.

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Stems					
'Anouk'	7-9	Purple	April-June	9"-12"	Silver-green foliage shows off the dark plum flower spikes, topped with violet bracts, which fade to pink as they mature.
'Anouk Purple Flare'	7-9	Indigo-Purple	April-June	9"-12"	Compact, densely branched with blue-grey foliage. Flower spikes are topped with distinctly shaped, indigo-colored bracts.
'Anouk Twilight'	7-9	Magenta-Purple	April-June	9"-12"	Symmetrical, upright appearance, with showy magenta-purple flowers displayed above the fragrant grey-green foliage.
Lavinova® 'Intense Purple'	7-9	Purple	April-July	9"-12"	Tidy, broadly-rounded appearance. Broad, pale-green leaves contrast with the elegant, rich purple flowers.
Lavinova® 'The Princess'	7-10	Bright Pink	April-May	9"-12"	The neat, compact and upright form is covered by fragrant, intense pink flowers, contrasting with the aromatic grey foliage.
