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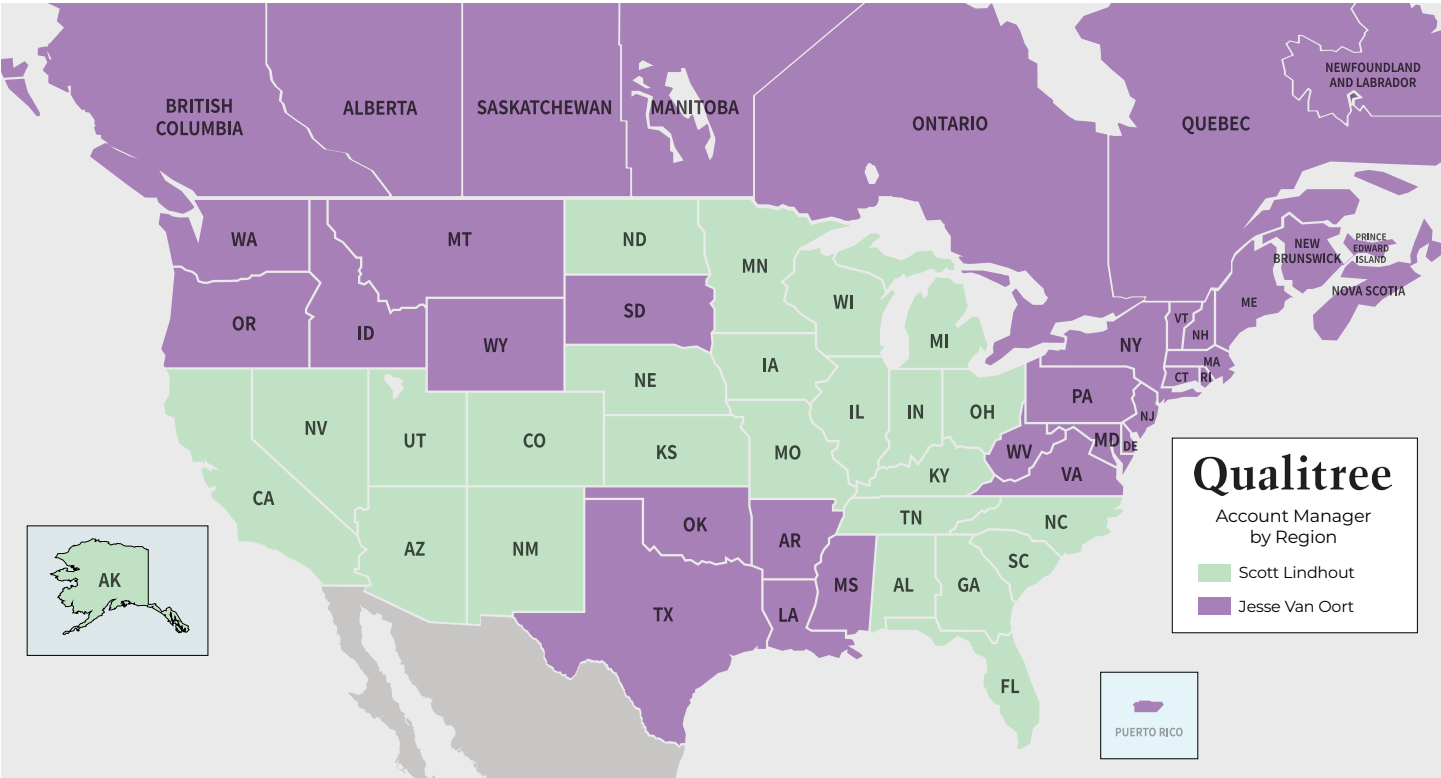

MINIMUMS & MULTIPLES

Young Plants | Liners

- Plug minimum shipment = 8 trays
- Order multiples = 4 trays
- 4"–6" pot sizes = 1 rack / crate minimum
- Order multiples = 1 shelf / 1 full crate

2 Gallon+ Pot Sizes

- 4 pallet minimum

- **Young Plant | Liners:** Bulk-up plugs and liners ready to be planted up for larger finishing sizes.
- **Retail Ready | Finished:** Plants grown to the desired finished size; ready to be sold directly to your consumers. Plants can also be used for shifting up into larger pot sizes.

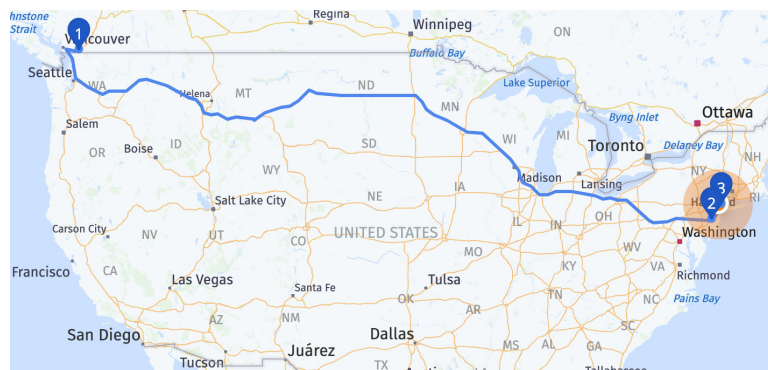

EMERALD GREEN ARBORVITAE

Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald Green' USDA Zone (3)4–7(8)

- Narrow, pyramidal evergreen with dense, emerald green foliage that holds its color throughout winter
- Thrives in the heat & humidity of the south; tolerates dry spells once established
- The most popular variety for hedging

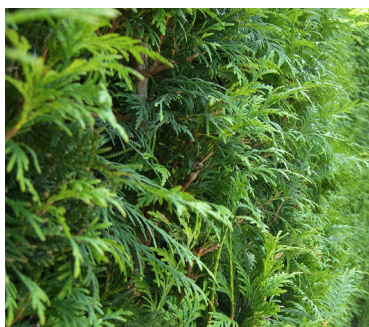


EMERALD SQUEEZE ARBORVITAE

Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald Squeeze' USDA Zone 4–8

- Everything you love about 'Emerald Green' in a smaller, more compact form
- Excellent cold hardiness and adaptability for hedging

GREEN GIANT ARBORVITAE

Thuja x 'Green Giant' USDA Zone 5–8

- Natural pyramidal/conical shape, boasting dense rich green foliage
- One of the finest evergreens for use as a privacy hedge
- Can tolerate southern heat

JANED GOLD ARBORVITAE

Thuja occidentalis 'Janed Gold' USDA Zone 5–8

- Tight, pyramidal-columnar form evergreen
- Shiny, bright gold foliage that becomes more golden with sun and heat; holds its golden color in winter
- Excellent for use in privacy hedges or accent plantings



LITTLE GIANT ARBORVITAE

Thuja occidentalis 'Little Giant' USDA Zone 4–7

4" – shipped 2,000 per pallet spot

#1 – shipped 452 per pallet spot

- Slow-growing, compact, globe-shaped evergreen
- Bright green foliage in warmer months & bronze accents in winter
- A perfect addition to gardens as a small hedge or border accent



SKYBOUND ARBORVITAE

Thuja occidentalis 'Skybound' USDA Zone 3–7

4" – shipped 2,000 per pallet spot

- Stately, low maintenance, columnar evergreen
- Excellent for use in mass plantings, hedging, or privacy screens
- Exceptional cold hardiness for northern markets

GOLDEN MOP

CHAMAECYPARIS PISIFERA FILIFERA 'GOLDEN MOP'

A LANDSCAPE CLASSIC

- USDA Zone: 4-8
- Coniferous, evergreen
- Shrub form, mounding habit
- Vibrant golden color
- Low-lying, distinctive form
- Great addition to planters as textural filler
- Adds interest in landscape settings
