Ability to Edit Uploaded Documents After User Has Published

Dash Portal Site Admins and Travel Managers who can add content and upload files to Company News, Leisure Specials, and Travel News can now edit an already published attachment, rather than deleting and republishing.

Travel Manager Side Menus and Return URL Not Working for Preferred Vendor Edit

For Travel Managers, the return URL and hide navigation parameters were not working on the edit view of the Preferred Vendors Admin page. They were updated so they behave like the rest of the admin pages for Travel Managers.

Fix URL Validation Bug on Travel Resources Admin Page

On the Travel Resources Admin page, the .NET function that validates URLs will occasionally falsely report a URL as invalid even if it is valid. If this occurs, a message will display to the user to warn them to check the validity of the URL, and a "Force Save" button has been added to allow the user to skip the URL validation and save the URL as-is.

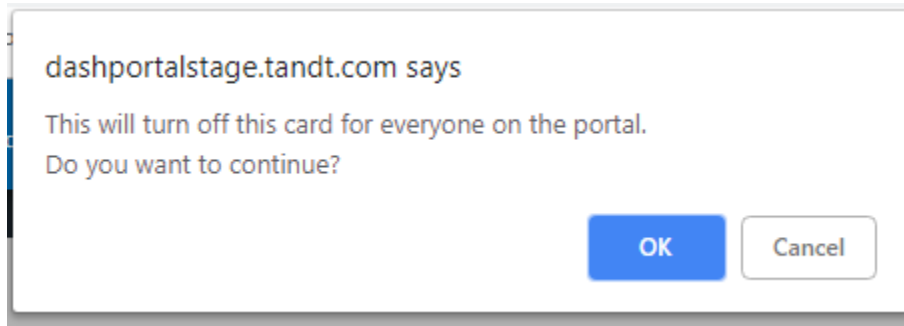

Hide Card Verification

When a Site Admin or Travel Manager clicks the eyeball icon on the hamburger menu to hide a card, they will see a message indicating that this will turn the card off for everyone on the portal. The user will need to click OK to proceed with disabling the card.
