Project scope

The Jurupa Valley site manufactures recycled resins made with post-consumer recycled content using mechanical recycling technology, with feedstock sourced primarily from municipal plastic waste recycling programs. These solutions are marketed under the *Circulen*Recover brand, one of the products in the company's circular and low carbon *Circulen* product portfolio. The Jurupa Valley mechanical recycling site has a production capacity of approximately 50 million pounds of recycled material per year.
