


U.S. NATIONAL PARKS: CANYONLANDS, ARCHES & ROCKY MOUNTAIN

THE BACKBONE OF NORTH AMERICA

As you journey through Rocky Mountain National Park, you'll encounter the Continental Divide, an immense ridge that separates the major watersheds of North America. Pay attention to the interplay of light and shadow across the mountains and observe the dramatic shifts in climate and terrain. This continental seam doesn't just direct the country's flow of water to the Atlantic or Pacific; it also marks significant changes in the landscape and ecosystems, affecting weather patterns, vegetation, and the types of wildlife found on either side.



A GEOLOGICAL WONDER

Canyonlands and Arches National Parks are a showcase of the power of natural geological forces. Observe layers of sedimentary rock that have been sculpted over millions of years by water and wind, resulting in towering pinnacles, deep canyons, massive buttes, and iconic arches. From the sprawling White Rim to the freestanding Delicate Arch, these rock formations tell a profound story of erosion and uplift. The forces that created them continue to shape them today, offering a dynamic glimpse into Earth's ongoing evolution.



GLENWOOD CAVERNS ADVENTURE PARK

As the only mountaintop adventure park in the country, Glenwood Springs offers a unique blend of natural beauty and human ingenuity.
