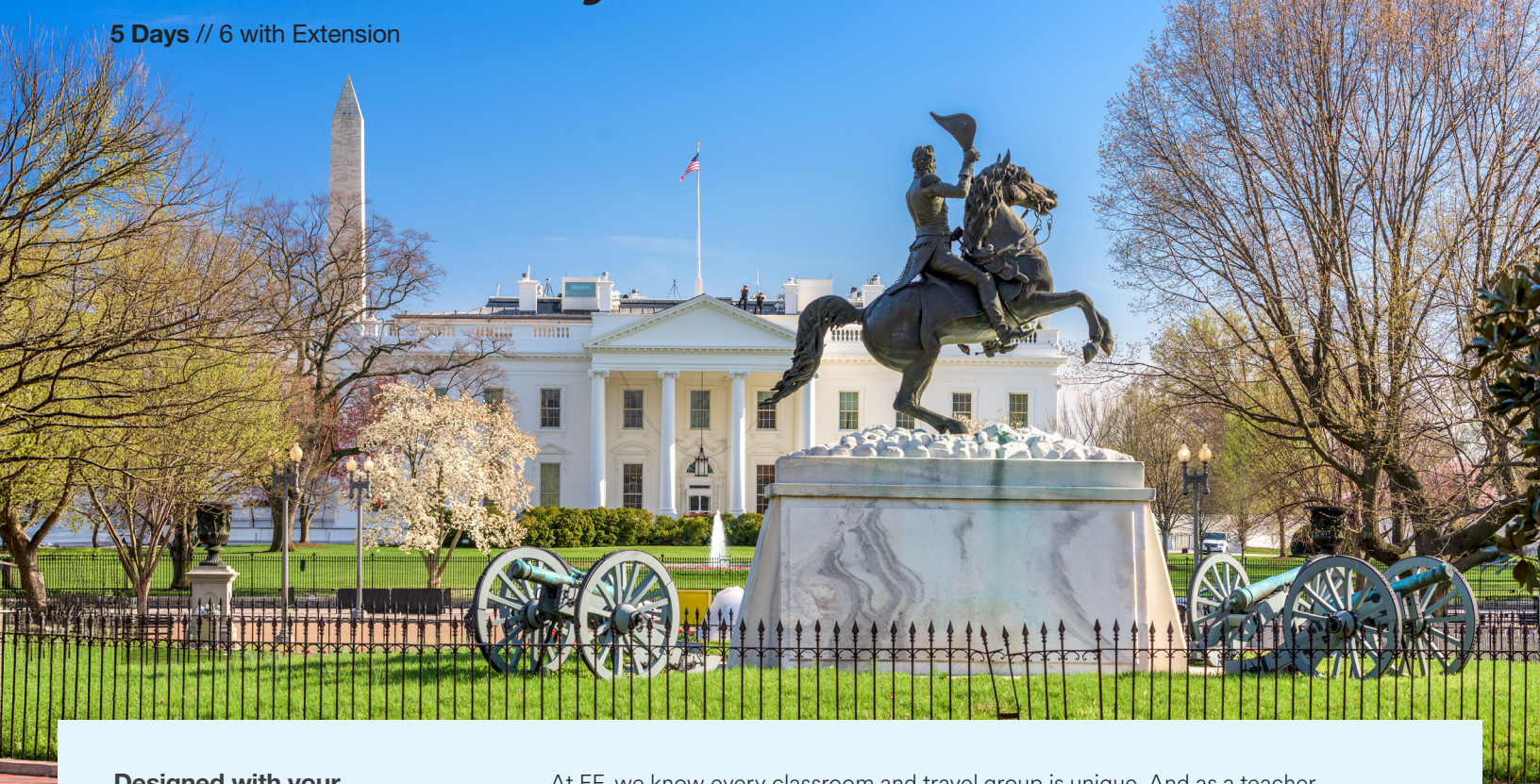

Day 1: Arrive in Washington, D.C.

- Photo stop at the Washington Monument
- World War II Memorial

Explore the Smithsonian, which may include visits to:

- National Museum of Natural History
- National Museum of American History
- National Museum of the American Indian

You Pick: Choose an additional museum to explore

- U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum
- Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum
- Smithsonian National Museum of African American History and Culture

Take a guided night tour of Washington, D.C. With your expert local guide you will see:

Day 2: Washington, D.C.

See the U.S. Capitol and Visitor Center

- The Women in Military Service for America Memorial

Make a photo stop at the Marine Corps War Memorial

Travel to New York City

- Empire State Building Observatory
- One World Observatory

Day 4: New York City

- Take a ferry to both islands and explore the powerful immigration history they share
- Sail past the islands on a guided boat tour and explore Lower Manhattan with an expert local guide

- Visit the National September 11 Memorial and Museum
- Take a survivor-led tour of Ground Zero with the 9/11 Tribute Association
