Global Citizen Scholarship Guidelines & Rubric

We believe every student should have the opportunity to discover the history, culture and beauty of the world firsthand. The Global Citizen Scholarship is one way we help make that possible.

EF's Global Citizen Scholarship guidelines and corresponding rubric are used to assess student applications and videos for scholarship recognition.

Submitted applications must include a completed form and video. You do not need to be on camera for your video. Each category will be assessed individually, and a final score is determined by calculating the average.

Each video must be **2-3 minutes** answering the question prompt:
How will travel change the way you think, feel, or act about the world?

- Explain your answer and its relevance to the world
- Reflect on your answer and connect it to your own life
- Provide enthusiasm for the global learning experience forthcoming
- Bring your story to life in an engaging, organized way
- Show awareness and understanding of other cultures
