What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Take a walking tour of London: Trafalgar Square; Covent Garden; The Strand; Leicester Square.

Day 3: London

- Take an expert-led tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled); St. Paul's Cathedral; Westminster Abbey.
- Time to see more of London or
 - Visit Windsor Castle.

Day 4: London | Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*. Then, admire the Notre-Dame Cathedral's sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Opéra district; Tuileries.
- Visit the Louvre.
- Visit Notre-Dame Cathedral.

Day 5: Paris

- Take an expert-led tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris or
 - Visit Versailles

Day 6: Loire Valley

- Visit Chartres Cathedral.
- Travel to the Loire Valley.
- Visit Chenonceau.

Day 7: Saintes | Bordeaux

- Travel to Bordeaux.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Bordeaux.

Day 8: Arcachon | Biarritz

- Travel to Arcachon.
- See the Dune du Pilat.
- Continue on to Biarritz.
- Take a tour of Biarritz.

Day 9: Biarritz

- Take a self-guided tour of San Sebastián.
- Take a walking tour of St. Jean de Luz.

Day 10: Pamplona | Barcelona

- Take a tour of Pamplona
- Continue on to Barcelona, an art lover's dream city and the place where masters like Miró, Picasso and Dalí flourished. During your stay you'll explore open-air plazas dotted with avant-garde gems, like the Plaza de Catalunya and Plaza España. Snap photos of the twisting spires of La Sagrada Família and admire the architectural wonders of Casa Batlló and Casa Milà. These iconic buildings, designed by Antoni Gaudí, showcase his unique style and innovative designs. Marvel at the landscaped greenery and playful Modernist mosaics on your visit to Park Güell. Flower vendors and street performers greet you as you walk the tree-lined Las Ramblas.

Day 11: Barcelona

- Take an expert-led tour of Barcelona, where you'll have the opportunity to snap photos of the twisting spires of La Sagrada Família.
- Visit Park Güell.
- Take a walking tour of Barcelona: Las Ramblas.
- Time to explore more of Barcelona or
 - Attend a Barcelona Flamenco Evening.

Day 12: Depart for home
