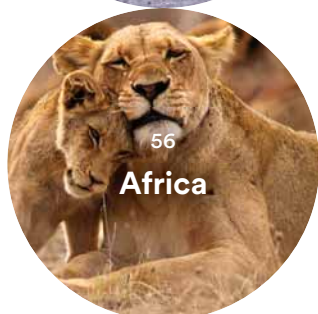

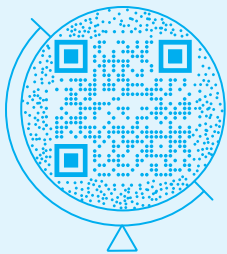

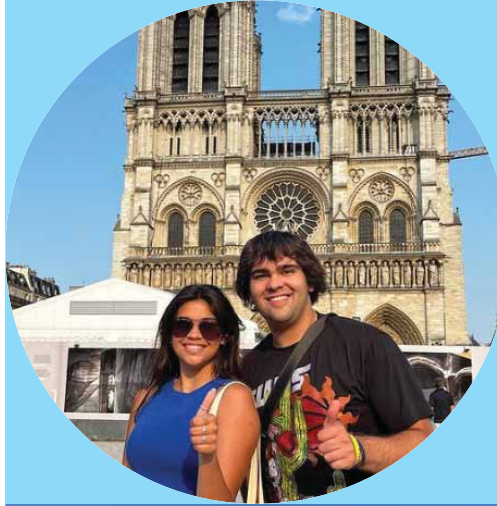
A sustainable stay

We launched the EF Forest Initiative in 2021 to restore healthy forests and support economic opportunities in rural communities worldwide. So far, through our partnership with Eden Reforestation Projects, local community members have planted more than 9 million mangrove trees on our behalf in Kenya, Madagascar, and Mozambique.



Tomorrow's engineers, inspired today



Traveling to Tokyo feels like stepping into the future. It's a wonderland for anyone even slightly interested in STEM innovations—and for people who are passionate about the subject, it's an absolute dream.

Students Carson P. and AJ V. are two such people, and lucky for them, they traveled to Tokyo (and beyond) on their school's *Robotics, Engineering & the Future of Cities in Japan* STEM tour. And out of all the hands-on, eye-opening moments they experienced, perhaps none made quite as large of an impact as their visit to a robotics manufacturer called Cyberdyne. There, the two friends experimented with wearable technology designed to help people with physical rehabilitation and spoke to real leaders in the field. Not only did they see the types of advancements that already exist, but they were inspired to start thinking about designing their own wearable tech to help even more people.

We caught up with Carson and AJ five months after returning home to see if their tour was continuing to have the lasting impact on them that they had predicted. They told us they constantly reminisce about their tour and talk

about how much they hope to return to Tokyo in the future—like through a college study abroad program. They've even started additional research on wearable tech, and Carson's been inspired to finish designing his own video game.

This is just the beginning for Carson and AJ, and we have a good feeling we'll see them on another EF STEM tour in the future. Only this time, *they'll* be the professional experts answering the next generation's questions.

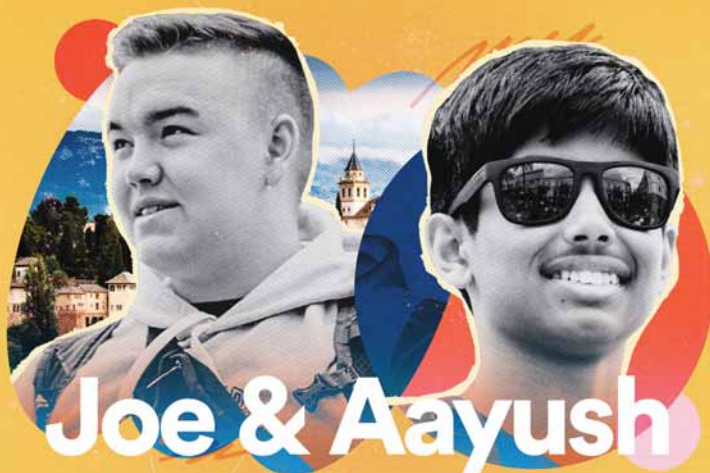

Bonded forever through travel

Consider the story of Joe P. and Aayush D., an unlikely pair of friends who never would have met if it weren't for their EF tour to Spain.



From roommates to friends

Joe was a rising senior, Aayush a sophomore. That alone could have been enough to keep them apart. However, as the only two boys on the trip, they were put together as roommates. "I think travel creates a bond that's kind of inseparable," Joe says. "When you're with someone for almost 24 hours a day for 12 days straight, you learn a lot about each other."

Experiencing independence, together

Joe and Aayush discovered that one of their favorite parts of travel was exploring on their own during free time. That taste of freedom led them to an amazing bakery—and some moments of getting a little lost. But the detour caused them to realize they could take care of themselves out in the real world, and it ended up being a highlight from their trip. "We felt confident enough that we could figure it out," Joe says.

The perks of peer-to-peer learning

They also witnessed the power of peer-to-peer learning firsthand. Aayush felt his Spanish skills were "rusty," and credits Joe for helping him practice and giving him tips. As a result, Aayush became more comfortable speaking Spanish. And after sharing his knowledge with the younger student, Joe did, too.

A traveler turned teacher feels the big impact of EF tours

As a high-schooler getting ready to travel to Europe for the first time on an EF tour, Billy couldn't have imagined all that lay ahead of him. Back then, he was a kid from Little Rock, Arkansas, who was just excited to explore new countries with his friends.
