The United States Capitol

Serving as the official meeting place of the U.S. Congress, the United States Capitol is one of the most iconic symbols of American democracy. The building has played a central role in the nation's history for more than two centuries and remains the setting where laws are debated and passed. In addition to its political significance, it's also known for impressive neoclassical architecture, historic chambers, and art-filled interiors, which offer visitors a deeper appreciation of the country's history and civic traditions.
