9 or 11 days | Dublin | Galway | Derry | Belfast | Extension to southeast Ireland



From rugged coastlines to rolling countrysides, charming villages to valleys dotted with sheep, experience Ireland's natural beauty and local culture. Travel beyond the major cities to explore the towering Cliffs of Moher by boat, wander past ancient rock formations at Giant's Causeway, and stop at small towns along the Atlantic coast. What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Ireland

Day 2: Dublin | Athlone

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.
- Take a walking tour of Dublin. With your Tour Director, see Grafton Street and the Temple Bar district.
- Travel to Athlone, located in the heart of Ireland.

Day 3: Athlone | Atlantic coast

- Take a day trip to the Atlantic coast. The drive alone offers prime views of the rugged cliffs and rolling hills the Emerald Isle's known for.
- See the Cliffs of Moher by boat. On your way to the staggering rock walls, disembark your ship to explore the island of Inis Oírr or spend your free time soaking. You may even spot the Plassey shipwreck, a rusted-out steam trawler that struck Finnis Rock in 1960. *(If inclement weather occurs, tours will visit the cliffs by land.)*

Day 4: Athlone | Galway | Castlebar region

- Travel to the Castlebar region via Galway.
- Take a walking tour of Galway and see River Corrib, Bowling Green, and other local sites recommended by your Tour Director.
- Explore Galway on your own.
- Visit Glengowla Mines, where you will tour the silver and lead mines and see a sheepdog demonstration.

Day 5: Castlebar region | Derry

- Travel via the western coast to Derry.
- Explore some of the region's small villages. Stops your Tour Director might recommend include Sligo, Bundoran (with its famous Fairy Bridges and Wishing Chair), and Donegal.
- Visit the Carrowmore Megalithic Cemetery.

Day 6: Derry | Belfast

- Take a guided tour of Derry. With your expert local guide you will visit St. Columb's Cathedral, see the Diamond War Memorial, and learn about the unique history of Derry.
- Visit Giant's Causeway, home to ancient rock formations comprised of hexagonal basalt columns formed 55 million years ago.
- Travel to Belfast.

Day 7: Belfast

- Visit the Ulster Folk Museum, a living museum where you can interact with people to learn what life was like in Northern Ireland in the early 20th century.
- Take a guided tour of Belfast. With your expert local guide you will learn about the history of this formerly divided city. You'll visit Falls Road and Shankill Road, notorious during the Troubles, and view the surrounding political murals. During this tour, you'll get a feel for what makes Belfast a vibrant, modern city today.
- Explore Belfast on your own.

Day 8: Belfast | Dublin

- Visit the EPIC Emigration Museum.
- Take a guided tour of Dublin. With your expert local guide you will see the Georgian squares, O'Connell Street, and St. Stephen's Green.
- Visit St. Patrick's Cathedral.

Day 9: Depart for home

Day 9: Dublin | Kilkenny | Waterford region

- Travel via Glendalough and Kilkenny to the Waterford region.
- Explore Glendalough, a glacial valley surrounded by lush mountains and a monastic settlement.
- Take a walking tour of Kilkenny, a city filled with medieval architecture.

Day 10: Waterford | Wexford | Dublin

- Visit the Waterford Treasures Museum to discover more about the area's Viking history.
- Explore Wexford on your own.
- Visit the Irish National Heritage Park open-air museum.
- Travel to Dublin.

Day 11: Depart for home
