From innovative thinking to public speaking, every moment at an EF Summit is designed to inspire growth.

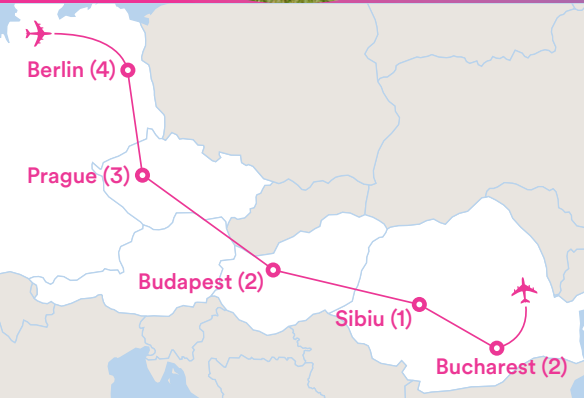
Project-based learning
