What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Austria

Day 2: Vienna

- Travel to Vienna. Residence of the imperial court for six centuries, Vienna is marked with the seal of the powerful Habsburgs, a family who once ruled over half of Europe.
- Compete in a “City Challenge” scavenger hunt.
- Enjoy an authentic Wiener Schnitzel dinner.

Day 3: Vienna

- Take an expert-led tour of Vienna: Ringstrasse; Parliament; Rathaus; Hofburg.
- Visit Schönbrunn Palace, where Marie Antoinette spent her childhood. When the 6-year-old Mozart performed here, he told the future queen of France, “I’ll marry you when I’m grown up!” After viewing the elegant interior, stroll through the palace’s beautifully landscaped gardens.
- Explore more of Vienna or [enjoy Viennese waltz dancing](#).
- Attend an evening of classical music in one of Vienna’s many traditional concert halls. Famed musicians such as Mozart, Beethoven, Haydn, Strauss, Brahms, and Schubert all have ties to the Austrian capital.

Day 4: Vienna | Prague

- Travel to Prague and encounter the legendary beauty of the former capital of the Holy Roman Empire. Located on the Vltava River, Prague gracefully balances the classical features of old Europe with a lively, bohemian spirit.
- Take a walking tour of Prague.

Day 5: Prague

- Take an expert-led tour of Prague: St. Vitus Cathedral; Wallenstein Palace Gardens (*April–October*); Lennon Wall; Charles Bridge; Old Town Square.

Day 6: Dachau | Munich

- Visit Dachau, a WWII Nazi concentration camp built in 1933 and liberated by the Allies in 1945. It now serves as a memorial museum.
- Travel to Munich.

Day 7: Munich

- Take an expertly guided tour of Munich: Olympic Stadium; Residenz; Marienplatz.
- Visit a Bavarian castle and admire the ornate halls built by European royalty.

Day 8: St. Gallen | Zurich

- Travel to St. Gallen, a university town that houses the famous Abbey Library.
- Take a walking tour of St. Gallen.
- Continue on to Zurich.

Day 9: Zurich

- Take a walking tour of Zurich’s Old Town, a collection of narrow, winding streets and medieval architecture.
- Visit the Romanesque-style Grossmünster church.
- Visit Lindt Home of Chocolate.

Day 10: Depart for home

Day 10: Bern

- Travel to Bern.
- Enjoy a cheese-making experience.

Day 11: Bern

- Visit the Bern Minster Cathedral.
- Take a sightseeing tour of Bern. You’ll visit the city’s mechanical clock tower, a medieval prison tower, the Rose Garden, and Zytglogge (a medieval clock tower featuring moving puppets, as well as the Münster, a 15th-century Gothic cathedral).
