ICELAND: GLACIERS & GEYSERS

7 days | Reykjavík | South Shore

Take advantage of round-the-clock daylight during the summer in this otherworldly place of dramatic beauty. Revel in the geothermal wonders of Iceland—Blue Lagoon hot springs, volcanic craters, and subarctic fauna. From the capital of Reykjavík you will travel the popular Golden Circle to see Gullfoss waterfall and the Geysir geothermal area. From there, continue on to one of the famous black sand beaches and Lava Centres on the South Shore.

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Reykjavík

- Board your overnight flight to Iceland.

Day 2: Reykjavík

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Reykjavík. Unable to decide if it's a small town or a big city, Reykjavík happily provides visitors with the best of both.
- Take a tour of Reykjavík.
- Visit the National Museum.

Day 3: South Shore

- Today you will explore the Golden Circle. Spanning a nearly 200-mile loop from Reykjavík into central Iceland, the Golden Circle encompasses many of the country's famous natural wonders.
- Take an excursion to Þingvellir National Park, which is home to Þingvallavatn, the largest natural lake in Iceland and a site of historical and geological importance.
- Take a geology walk.
- Visit the breathtaking Gullfoss waterfall.
- Visit Geysir, the namesake of every geyser in the world. Watch as Strokkur, another geyser, erupts every few minutes.
- Travel to the Hvolsvöllur area.
- Visit a geothermal greenhouse and Icelandic horse stable.

Day 4: South Shore

- Visit the Seljalandsfoss and Skógarfoss waterfalls, two of south Iceland's most famous natural wonders. Seljalandsfoss is a beautiful, 130-foot-high waterfall on the river Seljalandsá, while Skógarfoss is on the river Skógaá and has the title of one of the biggest in the country with a width of 80 feet and a drop of 200 feet. Legend has it that Prasi Þórólfsson—the first Viking settler in the area—buried a treasure in a cave behind it. On the eastern side, you'll be able to see the Sólheimajökull glacier.
- Visit the Skógarfoss Folk Museum
- Travel to a coastal village and enjoy one of their black sand beaches.
- Take the coolest walk of your life—literally—on Sólheimajökull Glacier.

Day 5: South Shore | Reykjavík

- Visit a state-of-the-art Lava Centre to learn about earthquakes and volcanic activity.
- Visit natural hot streams and geothermal springs.
- Travel to Reykjavík.

Day 6: Reykjavík

- Take an excursion to Alftanes peninsula.
- See Bessastaðir, official residence of the president.
- Continue on to Hafnarfjörður and Lake Kleifarvatn.
- See geothermal activity in Krísuvík geothermal field.
- Visit and bathe in the Blue Lagoon.

Day 7: Reykjavík | Depart for home

- Board your flight home.
