Activity level: Average; moderate walking (about 3 hours daily), and may include light hiking and climbing up hills or stairs

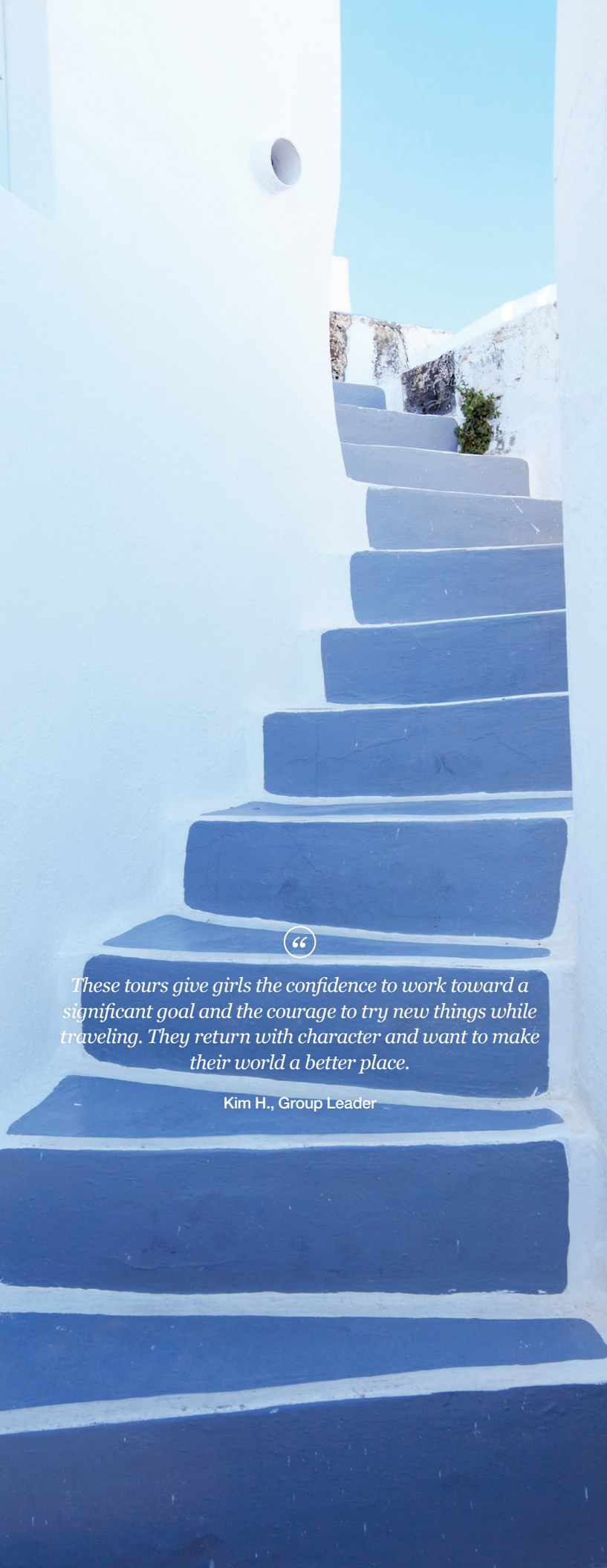

DAY 1: FLY OVERNIGHT TO ITALY

DAY 2: ROME

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other.

DAY 3: ROME

- Take an expert-led tour of Vatican City.
- Visit the Sistine Chapel, where you'll marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling.
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica on your own.
- + Visit the Catacombs.

DAY 4: ROME

- Take an expert-led tour of Rome.
- Visit the Colosseum, the world's most famous arena, where you'll almost be able to hear the stamping feet of crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat.
- Visit the Roman Forum, the former heart of the Roman Empire, where Julius Caesar gave many of his powerful political speeches.
- Continue on to Florence.

DAY 5: FLORENCE

- Welcome to Florence, the birthplace of the Italian language, opera, and the Renaissance. It's also where you'll find works of art like Michelangelo's statue of *David* and Botticelli's *The Birth of Venus*.
- Take an expert-led walking tour of Florence.
- See the Duomo.

DAY 6: ANCONA | NIGHT FERRY

- Travel to Ancona.
- Take a night ferry from Ancona to Igoumenitsa.

DAY 7: IGOUMENITSA | METEORA REGION

- Arrive in Igoumenitsa.
- Travel to the Meteora region.
- Take an expert-led tour of the Meteora monastery.

DAY 8: DELPHI | ATHENS

- Travel to Delphi.
- Take an expert-led tour of Delphi: Temple of Apollo.
- Visit the Delphi Museum.
- Continue on to Athens, and discover the ancient city named for Athena, goddess of war and wisdom.
 - ➦ Attend a Greek evening.

DAY 9: ATHENS

- Take an expert-led tour of Athens, including the Olympic Stadium, which hosted the first modern Olympics in 1896.
- Visit the Acropolis to view the Parthenon, perhaps the world's greatest architectural feat. Then see the Temple of Athena Nike, which once housed a gold statue of the goddess, her wings clipped to prevent her from deserting the city.
- Visit the Acropolis Museum.
- Take a walking tour of Athens through the Plaka District and Athenian Trilogy.

DAYS 10–12: GREEK ISLAND CRUISE

- Board your cruise ship for a three-day adventure that will take you to the islands and coastal towns of Greece. A three-island shore excursion package is included, featuring incredible sights that perfectly complement your comprehensive itinerary. White sand beaches helped make these destinations prized (and disputed) territories, while Turkish, Roman, and Greek influences helped shape the unique blend of cultures you'll encounter. You'll also enjoy on-board activities as you sail the beautiful crystalline waters.
