




The Hobby Plan

Take advantage of your personal fundraising page

EF gives everyone their own, unique fundraising page. However you're raising money, display a QR code or link to yours to encourage people to visit and donate.



Sell prints, crafts, or art commissions

⌚ 2–3 weeks 💰 \$0–40 ●●○ Medium effort

How it works: Gather pieces you've made in the past or take commissions.

- Promote your services in your community.
- Display your pieces on a table at school or promote them on your social media accounts.
- Bonus: Offer custom designs or bundles to encourage more sales.



Bake sale with travel-themed treats

⌚ 1–2 weeks 💰 \$10–50 ●●○ Medium effort

How it works: Host a bake sale centered around your travel destination.

- Gather family or friends to bake or prepare drinks.
- Promote the event in your community.



Offer music/art lessons

⌚ 2–3 weeks 💰 \$0 ●●● High effort

How it works: Teach friends, family, or community members and accept donations for your time.

- Schedule lessons over a 2–3 week period and promote your availability.
- Share your personal fundraising page so participants can donate.
