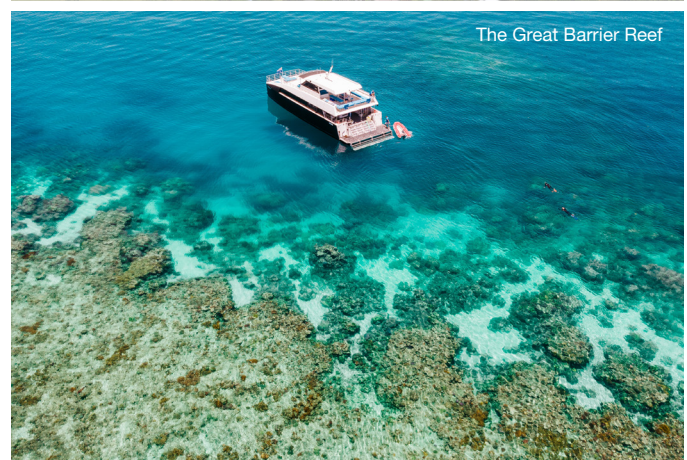
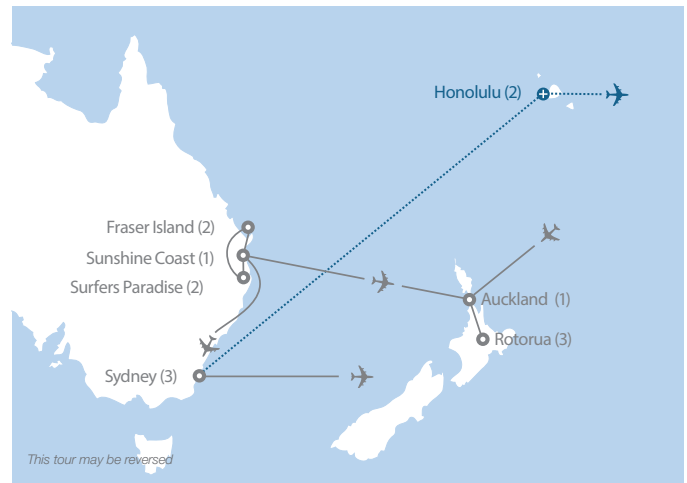

What you'll experience on your tour

Days 1-2: Fly to New Zealand

- Cross the International Date Line.

Day 3: Auckland | Rotorua

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.
- Travel to Rotorua, an area well-known for its geothermal activity and Māori culture.

Day 4: Rotorua

- Take a Rotorua duck tour and explore Rotorua's historic landmarks and natural wonders.
- Participate in an "Introduction to Jade in New Zealand" experience.
- Ride the Skyline Gondola.
- Visit the Agrodome for a sheep-shearing demonstration.

Day 5: Rotorua

- Visit the Rotorua geothermal area to marvel at bubbling pools of mud, crystal springs of hot mineral water, geysers, and richly colored craters.
- Visit a Māori village and hear about Māori legends and tribal customs.
- Enjoy a traditional *hāngi* dinner, complete with a Māori song and dance performance.

Day 6: Auckland

- Travel to Auckland.
- Take a tour of Auckland.

Day 7: Brisbane | Sunshine Coast

- Fly to Brisbane.
- Travel to the Sunshine Coast.

Day 8: Sunshine Coast

- Visit the coastal Noosa National Park and spend time relaxing on Noosa Heads Main Beach.
- Enjoy a free afternoon to explore more of the Sunshine Coast.

Day 9: Sunshine Coast | Fraser Island

- Take a ferry to Fraser Island, a stepping stone to the Great Barrier Reef. While here, be on the lookout for native wildlife, including wild horses, known here as *brumbies*.
- Explore rainforests, eucalyptus woodlands, sand dunes, and beaches on a Fraser Island excursion led by a National Park Ranger.

Day 10: Sunshine Coast | Surfers Paradise

- Continue on to Surfers Paradise, a town along Queensland's Gold Coast.

Day 11: Surfers Paradise

- Enjoy free time to explore or
 - ➦ enjoy a tour through the Surfers Paradise Hinterland rainforest.

Day 12: Surfers Paradise | Brisbane | Sydney

- Travel to Brisbane.
- Fly to Sydney, a stunning, cosmopolitan city of 4.6 million people that boasts world-class beaches, iconic architecture, and breathtaking natural wonders.

Day 13: Sydney

- Visit Sydney Tower, the second-tallest building south of the equator, where you'll enjoy a bird's-eye view of the city from the observation deck.
- Take a tour of Sydney.
- Enjoy a ferry ride across the harbor to Watsons Bay, Australia's oldest fishing village.
- Enjoy an "Introduction to Opal in Australia" experience.
- Take a walking tour of the Rocks neighborhood.

Day 14: Sydney

- Enjoy a full day to see more of Sydney or
 - ➦ explore more of the Sydney Harbor area with a tour of the world-famous Opera House, a visit to Luna Park, and more.

Day 15: Depart for home
