Take in this tour's highlights

Paris

See the most iconic landmarks of Paris with an expert local guide. Circle around Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe, ride down the Champs-Élysées, see the glittering dome of Les Invalides, and stop at the perfect spot to snap the ultimate Eiffel Tower photo.

Barcelona

Join an expert local guide and see Barcelona's most beloved and unique architectural achievements. Admire the façade of La Sagrada Família and stroll through Park Güell, both designed by Antoni Gaudí. Then travel to the top of Montjuïc, once the birthplace of Barcelona.

French Riviera

Walk through Nice's top city sights like the Vieille Ville and the Promenade des Anglais with your Tour Director.

Discover a quainter side of the south of France on a day trip to Monaco and Èze, where a visit to a perfume factory gives you insight into the making of famous French scents.

Florence

Study up on the city's history during a walking tour with an expert local guide. Spot the Ponte Vecchio, Chiesa di Santa Croce, Gates of Paradise, and Piazza della Signoria. Prepare for a jaw-dropping moment when you first see the world-famous Duomo.

Rome

Walk in the footsteps of Julius Caesar *and* gladiators all in one afternoon with an expert local guide. While the Colosseum definitely lives up to the hype, the Roman Forum is often an unexpected favorite.

Cross classic Roman sites off your bucket list as you embark on a self-guided walking tour. Wind around seemingly ordinary corners and happen upon iconic spots like Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps.
