Melbourne

Embark on a walking tour of the city with your Tour Director. As you amble through alleyways splashed with street art and stroll past grand Victorian arcades, you'll get an instant feel for the famously creative and dynamic energy of Australia's cultural capital.

Venture to Phillip Island at sunset to witness the world-famous Penguin Parade, where hundreds of little penguins waddle ashore after a day of fishing, while rangers share about the sustainable efforts that protect this nightly ritual.

Marvel at native animals like koalas, kangaroos, and platypuses at Healesville Sanctuary. Learn from wildlife experts as they reveal how conservation projects safeguard Australia's famous fauna.

Cairns

Spend a full day on the magnificent Great Barrier Reef, one of the natural wonders of the world. Swim and snorkel your way through the dazzling blue ocean and discover the beauty of the underwater world around you—the electric colors of tropical fish, swaying plants, and exquisite corals.

Sydney
