
## **EPCOT**

Students can travel the world at Disney's EPCOT®, considered to be a permanent World's Fair. Stroll past a replica of Venice's Doge's Palace at the Italy pavilion, sample shawarma in Morocco, and listen to traditional mariachi music in Mexico. Then, go out of this world on Mission: SPACE, located on the Future World side of this sprawling park. During this ride, you'll experience NASA-style training and a simulated space launch.




#### **CAPE CANAVERAL**

Cape Canaveral has played a storied role in the history of the American space program. The first rocket launched from the site, called Bumper 8, blasted off on July 24, 1950. In the decades that followed, NASA's Mercury, Gemini, and Apollo flights were launched from Cape Canaveral, as were all of the Space Shuttles. The Cape was specifically chosen as a launch site because its southerly location allows rockets to take maximum advantage of the Earth's rotation velocity, which is fastest closer to the equator.
