What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Greece

Day 2: Athens

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Athens.
- Start your stay off with a walking tour of the Plaka district, the oldest neighborhood in Athens, and Syntagma Square.

Day 3: Athens

- Take a guided tour of Athens. See the city's ancient Olympic Stadium, its central square, and the Acropolis with an expert local guide.
- Visit the Acropolis to view the Parthenon, one of the world's greatest architectural feats, and see the Temple of Athena Nike.
- Discover prehistoric artifacts and ancient ruins at the Acropolis Museum.
- Explore Athens on your own or [enjoy a cooking class](#).

Day 4: Athens

- Explore Athens on your own or [take a Saronic Islands cruise](#).

Day 5: Athens | Corinth | Argolida region

- Travel via Corinth to Argolida.
- See the sparkling waters of the Corinth Canal, which separates the Peloponnese region from the Greek mainland and made the former Peloponnese peninsula an island.
- Visit the Acropolis of Mycenae and the Treasury of Atreus (better known as Agamemnon's Tomb) with an expert local guide.
- Learn about traditional clay techniques at a Mycenaean pottery studio.

Day 6: Nafplio | Argolida region | Athens

- Visit the Palamidi Fortress, which offers views of the crystalline Argolic Gulf and is one of the greatest achievements of Venetian fortification architecture.
- Explore the seaside town of Nafplio, the first capital of the modern state of Greece.
- Enjoy a traditional Greek lunch in Nafplio.
- Enjoy a short boat ride through Nafplio Bay (*weather pending*).
- Travel back to Athens.

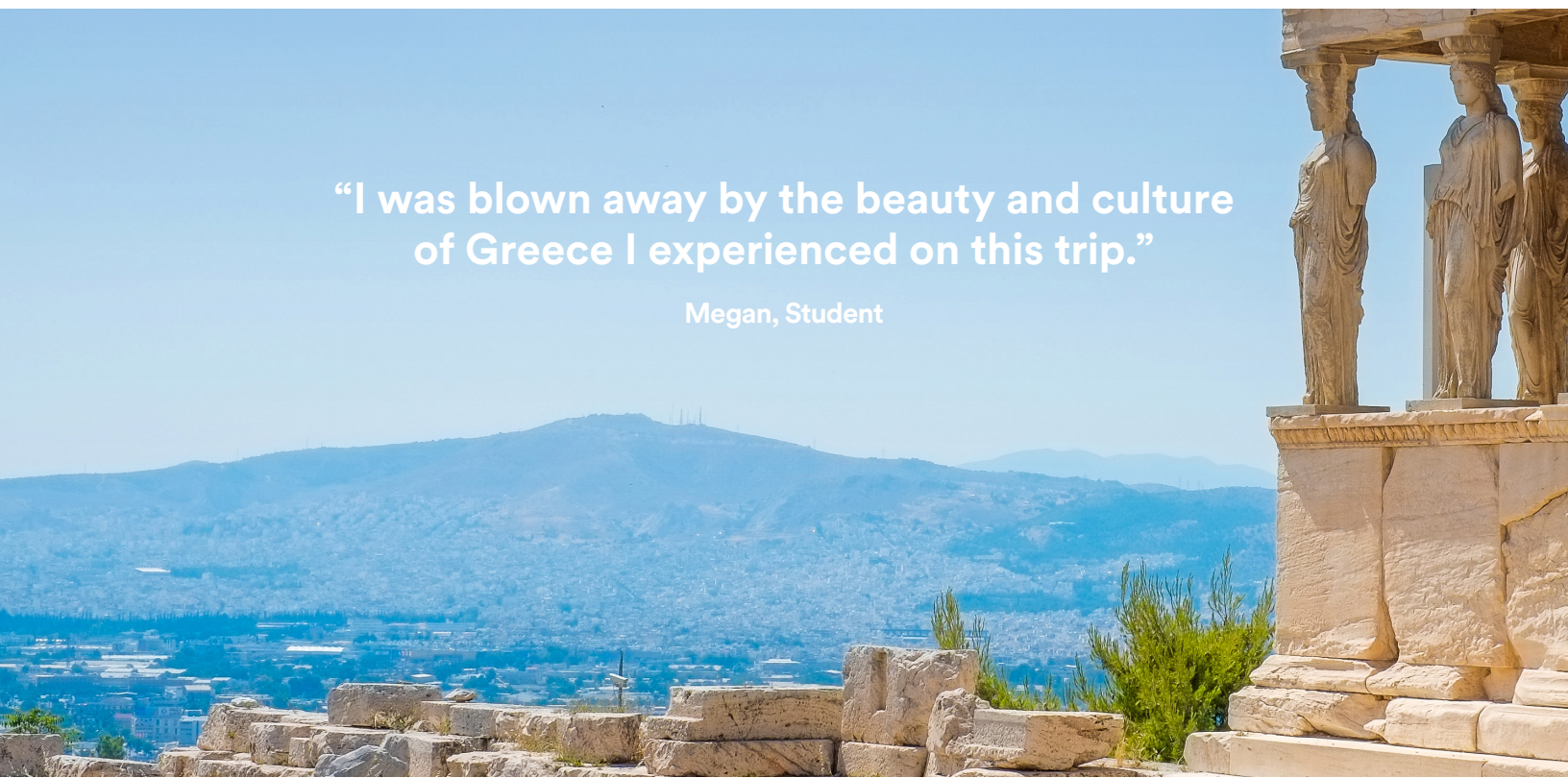
