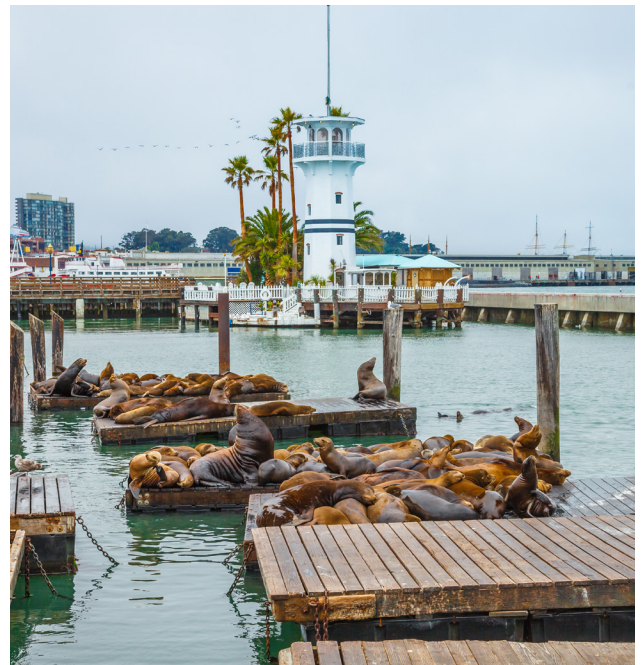

**Day 1: San Francisco**

Meet your Tour Director at the airport in San Francisco, home to some of the world’s largest technology companies like Google, Meta, and Apple. Cruise the streets of the Bay Area and see Chinatown and Fisherman’s Wharf. Then discuss the engineering marvels of the Golden Gate Bridge and the eight hairpin turns of Lombard Street. Finish your day riding one of San Francisco’s historic cable cars, which date back to the 19th century.

**Day 2: San Francisco**

Dive into the California tech scene with a walking tour of downtown San Francisco. Start at the Salesforce Tower, the tallest building in San Francisco, and then participate in a STEM workshop. After lunch, dive further into science, art, and human perception at the Exploratorium. After dinner, enjoy an interactive, team-based scavenger hunt.

**Day 3: Silicon Valley**

Head south into Silicon Valley for an interactive, tech-centered workshop. Then, snap a selfie at Intel Headquarters, where you’ll journey through decades of innovation inside the Intel Museum. Spend the afternoon learning about the engineering, computer science, and biomedical programs at Stanford University.

**Day 4: San Francisco | Depart for home**

Visit the California Academy of Sciences and take a behind-the-scenes tour to see how this 160-year-old institution is able to house over 46 million specimens. Later, take in some 360-degree views from the top of the Hamon Observation Tower before boarding your plane home.

**Day 4: Marin County**
