SCHOOL IN THE 1800S

Costumed schoolmarms and school masters welcome visitors looking to learn more about California’s early days of education. Located in the capital city’s historic Old Sacramento area, this museum is a living replica of what students could expect if they were going to school in the late 1800s. Featuring a pot-bellied stove, vintage student desks, and other furnishings from the 19th century, this schoolhouse is constantly being used for a place of learning.
