

DAY 1: FLY OVERNIGHT TO ITALY

DAY 2: ROME

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other.

DAY 3: ROME

- Take an expert-led tour of Vatican City.
 - Visit the Sistine Chapel, where you'll marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling.
 - Visit St. Peter's Basilica on your own.
 - ➕ Visit the Catacombs.

DAY 4: ROME

- Take an expert-led tour of Rome.
 - Visit the Colosseum, the world's most famous arena, where you'll almost be able to hear the stamping feet of crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat.
 - Visit the Roman Forum, the former heart of the Roman Empire, where Julius Caesar gave many of his powerful political speeches.
 - Continue on to Florence.

DAY 5: FLORENCE

- Welcome to Florence, the birthplace of the Italian language, opera, and the Renaissance. It's also where you'll find works of art like Michelangelo's statue of *David* and Botticelli's *The Birth of Venus*.
 - Take an expert-led walking tour of Florence.
 - See the Duomo.

DAY 6: ANCONA | NIGHT FERRY

- Travel to Ancona.
 - Board your overnight ferry from Ancona to Igoumenitsa.

DAY 7: IGOUMENITSA | METEORA REGION

- Arrive in Igoumenitsa.
- Travel to the Meteora region.
- Take an expert-led tour of the Meteora monastery.

DAY 8: DELPHI | ATHENS

- Travel to Delphi.
- Take an expert-led tour of Delphi: Temple of Apollo.
- Visit the Delphi Museum.
- Continue on to Athens, and discover the ancient city named for Athena, goddess of war and wisdom.
 - ➦ Attend a Greek evening.

DAY 9: ATHENS

- Take an expert-led tour of Athens, including the Olympic Stadium, which hosted the first modern Olympics in 1896.
- Visit the Acropolis to view the Parthenon, perhaps the world's greatest architectural feat. Then see the Temple of Athena Nike, which once housed a gold statue of the goddess, her wings clipped to prevent her from deserting the city.
- Visit the Acropolis Museum.
- Take a walking tour of Athens through the Plaka District and Athenian Trilogy.

DAYS 10: ATHENS | SANTORINI

- Fly to Santorini.
- Take a walking tour of the coastal village of Perissa and see the famous black sand beach.
- Take a walking tour of Pyrgos.
- Enjoy more time and take in one of Oia's world-famous sunsets.

DAYS 11: SANTORINI | HERAKLION

- Enjoy time to explore in the morning.
- Travel to Athinios port.
- Take a hydrofoil to Heraklion, the largest city in Crete.

DAYS 12: HERAKLION | NIGHT FERRY

- Visit Knossos Palace with an expert local guide.
- Take a guided boat tour of Spinalonga, a historic fortress island
- Enjoy time to explore or go to the beach.
- Board your overnight ferry from Heraklion to Athens.
