EL YUNQUE NATIONAL FOREST

With a name derived from the Taíno word Yuké, referencing its cloud-covered summits, El Yunque enchants on many levels. It's the only tropical rainforest in the U.S. Forest System and is home to over 250 types of flora and nearly 100 types of wildlife, including five endangered species and 13 species of the rare coqui tree frog.

Founded in the early 16th century, Old San Juan is a treasure trove of Spanish colonial architecture, with colorful buildings, historic churches, and charming plazas around every corner. This cultural district has stood resilient through centuries of battles and sieges, playing a crucial role in the defense of the New World against legendary figures like Sir Francis Drake. Today, it's a UNESCO World Heritage Site and offers its visitors the chance to shop, dine, and enjoy stunning views of San Juan Bay.
