Working on a local international team, you'll use the design thinking process to create and present solutions to a global challenge.

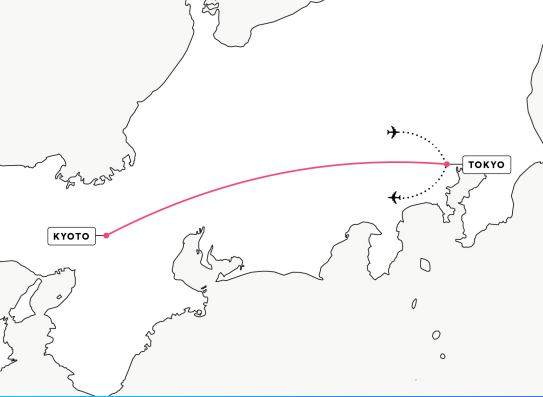
