What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to Costa Rica

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in San José.
- Travel to Alajuela.

Day 2: Alajuela | Arenal region

- Travel to the Arenal region, where you'll behold a perfect conical shape emerging from the green hills of Alajuela: this is the fascinating Arenal Volcano. Overlooking the San Carlos plain and the Pacific lowlands, this mile-high volcano has been active for the past 7,000 years.
- Start the day with a coffee tour and see how Costa Rica produces some of the world's best coffee beans. Learn about the entire supply chain of this famous Costa Rican crop—from the fields where it's grown to the cafes where it's brewed—and discover coffee's essential role in the country's economy.

Day 3: Arenal region

- Soar through the canopy at exhilarating speeds and experience tropical flora and fauna from a new perspective. Costa Rica's rainforests provide the perfect natural setting for a ziplining adventure.
- Try your hand at creating local culinary specialties during a visit to a working mill.

Day 4: Arenal region | Sarapiquí

- Spend the morning hiking in Arenal Volcano National Park, where you'll witness breathtaking vistas of the volcano and surrounding countryside. Keep an eye out for monkeys, toucans, and colorful butterflies.
- Learn how to dance salsa with a local teacher.
- Travel to Sarapiquí.

Day 5: Sarapiquí

- Visit a local pineapple farm and meet the people who plant, harvest, and export the fruits. Learn about the vital role of peri-urban gardens and the interconnectedness of agriculture, ecology, conservation, and culture in rural Costa Rica.
- Take a chocolate tour at the Tirimbina Biological Reserve.

Day 6: Sarapiquí | Alajuela

- Visit Braulio Carrillo National Park, one of Costa Rica's most diverse and ecologically important areas. Enjoy a guided walk and an aerial tram.
- Travel to Alajuela.
