What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Italy

Day 2: Rome

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other.

Day 3: Rome

- Take an expert-led tour of Rome, where you will see the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, Capitoline Hill, and the Jewish Ghetto.
- Take a guided food walking tour and enjoy an included lunch or dinner while learning about Italian cuisine and exploring Rome's historic streets.

Day 4: Rome | Florence

- Take an expert-led tour of Vatican City.
- Visit the Sistine Chapel and experience its breathtaking domed ceiling. From Michelangelo's frescoes to Raphael's tapestries, Pope Sixtus IV commissioned the masters of the day to cover nearly every inch of the Chapel in art depicting important Biblical scenes.
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica on your own. While you explore, look for the papal protectors who flank the entrance: they're the highly trained soldiers of Vatican City's Pontifical Swiss Guard.
- Travel to Florence, the birthplace of the Italian language and opera. Florence was the epicenter of the Renaissance movement from the 14th to 16th century, and is the former home of artists like Michelangelo and Botticelli.

Day 5: Florence

- Take an expert-led tour of Florence including the Piazza della Signoria, Ponte Vecchio, Chiesa di Santa Croce, and Gates of Paradise.
- Visit the Duomo.
- Time to explore on your own or [visit Pisa](#).

Day 6: Florence | Tyrol region

- Travel via Verona to the Tyrol region.

Day 7: Tyrol region | Munich

- Visit the Bergisel Ski Jump, which stands

proudly above the Olympic city of Innsbruck and was the first ski jump built on this historic ground in 1925.

- Travel to Munich, where you'll experience the medieval to the modern. During your stay you'll see the Olympic Stadium, BMW headquarters, the fashionable Schwabing district and the Residenz, former home of the Wittelsbach Dukes of Bavaria. In Marienplatz, see the neo-Gothic New City Hall with its famous Glockenspiel. Then continue past the famous Hofbräuhaus, once the royal brewery of the Kingdom of Bavaria.

Day 8: Munich

- Take an expert-led tour of Munich, where you'll see Olympic Stadium and the Residenz.
- Visit Dachau, a WWII Nazi concentration camp built in 1933 and liberated by the Allies in 1945. It now serves as a memorial museum.

Day 9: Depart for home

Day 9: Munich | Prague

- Travel to Prague.
- Take a walking tour of Prague.

Day 10: Prague

- Take an expert-led tour of Prague, including Prague Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, Wallenstein Palace Gardens (*April-October*), Lennon Wall, Charles Bridge, and Old Town Square.
- Time to explore more of Prague.
