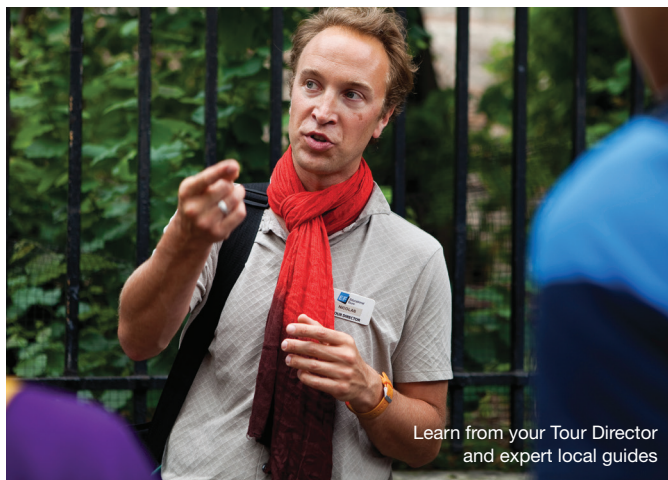
YOU'RE GOING TO EXPERIENCE IT.

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Days 2–3: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn.
- Take a walking tour of London: Trafalgar Square; Covent Garden.
- Take an expert-led tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; Westminster Abbey.

Days 4–5: Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light.
- Take an expert-led tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Eiffel Tower.
- Take a walking tour of Paris.
- Visit the Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.
- Enjoy a Seine River cruise.
- Time to see more of Paris or [visit Versailles](#).

Days 6–7: Lucerne region

- Travel through the Burgundy region to the Lucerne region.
- Take a walking tour of Lucerne.
- Enjoy a thoroughly Swiss experience as you travel to the top of the Alps, take a boat across Lake Lucerne (*seasonal*), and ride a cog railway to either Mount Pilatus or Mount Rigi.

Days 8–9: Florence

- Take an expert-led tour of Florence.
- Time to see more of Florence or [visit Pisa](#).

Day 10: Assisi

- Travel to Assisi.
- Visit the Basilica of St. Francis.

Days 11–12: Assisi | Pompeii | Sorrento region

- Travel to Pompeii.
- Take an expert-led tour of Pompeii.
- Travel to the Sorrento region or [visit Capri](#).
- Continue on to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other.

Days 13–14: Rome | Athens | Delphi

- Take an expert-led tour of Rome, where you will see the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, Capitoline Hill, and St. Peter's Square in Vatican City.
- Take a guided food walking tour. Discover Italian cuisine and enjoy lunch or dinner while strolling through Rome's historic streets.
- Fly to Athens.
- Travel to Delphi.

- Take an expert-led tour of Delphi.
- Visit the Delphi site.

- Continue on to Athens.
- Take an expert-led tour of Athens.
- Visit the Acropolis.

- Depart for home.
