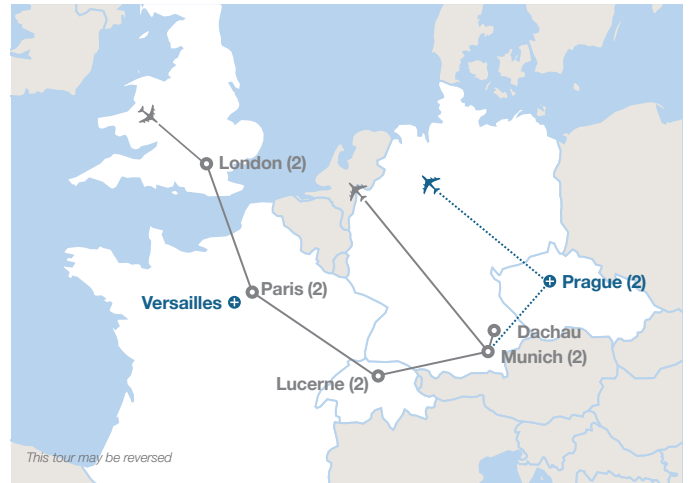

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own.
- From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn during your walking tour of the city.

Day 3: London

- During an expert-led tour of London, admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.

Day 4: London | Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light.
- Get a taste of Parisian style as you explore the city on a walking tour.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.
- During your visit to the renowned Louvre, you'll see I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marking the entrance to the home of treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*.
- Enjoy a Seine River cruise.

Day 5: Paris

- On your expert-led tour of Paris, you'll ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower.

Day 6: Burgundy | Lucerne

- Travel through Burgundy to Lucerne.

Day 7: Lucerne

- Take a tour of Lucerne, where you'll see Löwendenkmal (the Lion Monument) and Kapellbrücke (Chapel Bridge).
- Enjoy a thoroughly Swiss experience as you travel to the top of the Alps, take a boat across Lake Lucerne (*seasonal*), and ride a cog railway to either Mount Pilatus or Mount Rigi.

Day 8: Lucerne | Zurich | Liechtenstein | Munich

- Travel via Zurich and Liechtenstein to Munich.
- Stop in Zurich and visit the Lindt House of Chocolate.
- Continue on to Liechtenstein for free time to explore.
- Arrive in Munich, where you'll experience everything from the medieval to the modern.

Day 9: Munich

- During your expert-led tour of Munich, you'll see the Olympic Stadium and the Residenz, former home of the Wittelsbach Dukes of Bavaria. In Marienplatz, see the neo-Gothic New City Hall with its famous Glockenspiel.
- Visit Dachau, a WWII Nazi concentration camp built in 1933 and liberated by the Allies in 1945. It now serves as a memorial museum.
- Take a walking tour of Munich.

Day 10: Depart for home

- Arrive in Prague and take a walking tour of the city.

Day 11: Prague

- Take an expert-led tour of Prague, where you'll see St. Vitus Cathedral, Wallenstein Palace Gardens (*April-October*), Lennon Wall, Charles Bridge, and Old Town Square.

Day 12: Depart for home
