Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Days 2-4: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.

Davs 5-7: Paris

Continue on to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other. During your stay, explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum. On your visit to the Vatican City, marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of the Vatican City. Before you say arrivederoi, toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.
