Take in this tour's highlights

Tokyo

CULTURAL JAPAN Visit Asakusa Kannon Temple, Tokyo's oldest Buddhist building, where restaurants, theaters, and cinemas surround a five-story pagoda—a perfect symbol of an enduring past and innovative future.

Enjoy a traditional Japanese tea ceremony, created for nobility during Japan's medieval period.

Step back in time on a walking tour of the Yanaka Ginza district. The nostalgic pedestrian street, packed with quaint shops of all kinds, gives you a glimpse into what mid-20th-century Tokyo was like.

MODERN JAPAN Wander through the immersive exhibits at teamLab Borderless, a futuristic display of continuous art without boundaries where you become part of the experience.

Take a walking tour of Akihabara Electric Town, a cultural center for fans of anime and its comics counterpart, manga. The neon-infused atmosphere is intended to make you feel like you're inside a video game, with popular anime characters on display throughout shops and cafes.

Channel your inner gamer at the arcades in Akihabara and enjoy countless retro video games in this hobbyist wonderland.

Yokohama

METROPOLITAN JAPAN Take a day trip to Yokohama, a port city within Greater Tokyo known for shopping, high-tech businesses, and a bustling Chinatown. Find your way around this trendy suburb during an immersive scavenger hunt, where you'll solve puzzles with your group.

Yokohama (cont.) Visit the Shin-Yokohama Ramen Museum and learn all about the history and culture of Japan's renowned noodle soup. See firsthand how this slurpable specialty gets made in the world's first interactive ramen experience.

Ride the Cosmo Clock 21 Ferris Wheel, which at a height of 112 meters provides stunning panoramic views of Tokyo bay.

Bōsō Peninsula

RURAL JAPAN Take a break from the non-stop energy of Tokyo on a day trip to the Bōsō Peninsula, where you'll experience more of what rural Japan has to offer.

Ride the aerial tram to the top of Mt. Nokogiri, where you might just see Mount Fuji on a clear day.

Visit the Nihonji Temple, a Soto Zen Buddhist site constructed over 1,300 years ago on the slopes of Mt. Nokogiri. The highlight is a 100-foot Daibutsu, a statue of Yakushi Buddha.
