What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Spain

Day 2: Madrid

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Madrid, the capital and largest city in Spain. During your stay you'll explore Puerta del Sol, the heart of the city, and travel back in time to Spain's Golden Age at Plaza Mayor, where you'll learn about this grand square's history of bullfights, royal weddings, and public executions. At the Prado Museum, behold paintings like Velázquez's Las Meninas and Goya's paired canvases. Get a taste of royal Madrid at the extravagant Palacio Real, where you'll wander the fabulous palace interior and find more than 2,000 rooms filled with beautiful frescoes, delicate porcelain wares, and finely woven rugs.
- Take a walking tour of Madrid.

Day 3: Madrid

- Take an expert-led tour of Madrid: Puerta del Sol; Plaza Mayor.
- Visit the Palacio Real.
- Visit the Prado Museum.

Day 4: Madrid | Córdoba

- Travel to Córdoba, where you'll see influences of the Moorish, Roman, Jewish, and Christian cultures that flourished here at different times in the city's history. At its height, this Spanish city was home to 70 libraries, 900 public baths, and 700 mosques. During your stay you'll visit the Mezquita, once a sacred Muslim site and the largest mosque west of Mecca. Borrowing from Persian, Roman, and Gothic architecture, the Moors erected this magnificent structure in the 8th century. In the very center of the complex, you'll discover a massive cathedral, added in the 13th century after King Ferdinand III conquered the city and Christianity reigned.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Córdoba: Patio de los Naranjos.
- Visit the Mezquita.
- Learn how to make tapas.

Day 5: Córdoba | Seville

- Travel to Seville, the city of bullfights, flamenco dancing, Don Juan, and Carmen, and the heartbeat of Andalusian culture. During your stay you can follow narrow, twisting alleys through the Barrio de Santa Cruz, where picturesque whitewashed houses, flowerfilled patios, and tiled benches are pleasant reminders of an unhurried lifestyle. Pass by María Luisa Park to admire the mosaics and fountains of Plaza de España, the centerpiece of the 1929 Ibero-American Exposition. Visit the Moorish Alcázar and the grave of Christopher Columbus inside Seville's Cathedral. Finally, imagine the spectacle of a traditional Spanish bullfight at the Plaza de Toros, celebrated for its Baroque architecture and historical significance.
- Take a walking tour of Seville: Giralda Tower;
 Torre del Oro; Plaza de Toros.
- Visit the Setas de Sevilla.
- Free time to see more of Seville or
 enjoy an evening river cruise.

Day 6: Seville

- Take an expert-led tour of Seville.
- Visit the Seville Alcázar.
- Visit the Seville Cathedral.
- Enjoy a free evening or
- attend a Seville flamenco evening.

Day 7: Seville | Toledo | Madrid

- Take an expert-led tour of Toledo: Toledo Cathedral; Church of Santo Tome & Synagogue.
- Return to Madrid.

Day 8: Depart for home

- Travel by AVE train to Barcelona.
- Take a walking tour of Barcelona: Las Ramblas.

Day 9: Barcelona

- Stop for a photo at Montjuïc.

- Visit Park Güell.
