

## What you'll experience on your tour

#### Day 1: Fly overnight to England

### Day 2: London | Canterbury

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London. Then travel to Canterbury, a historic city southeast of London encircled with medieval walls built by the Romans in the late 3rd century.
- Take a walking tour of Canterbury.

## Day 3: Canterbury | London

- Visit Canterbury Cathedral.
- Visit the Westgate Tower Museum and Gardens. The Westgate is England's largest surviving gateway built to defend Canterbury during the Hundred Years' War.
- Travel back to London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn.
- Take a walking tour of London: The Strand;
   Trafalgar Square; Leicester Square;
   Covent Garden.

#### Day 4: London

- Take an expert-led tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus;
   St. Paul's Cathedral; Westminster Abbey;
   Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled).
- Take an expert-led tour of Windsor Castle: St. George's Chapel; Queen Mary's Dolls' House; State Apartments.
- Enjoy an authentic fish and chips dinner.

### Day 5: London

- Visit the British Museum.
- Explore more of London on your own or
   take a "Wicked Women of London" walking tour.

#### Day 6: London | Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.
- On your visit to the Louvre, see where I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned museum, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*. Be sure to get an up-close look at her beguiling smile.

#### Day 7: Paris

- Take an expert-led guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris or visit Versailles.

#### Day 8: Paris

- Take a walking tour of Montmarte. Once home to many formerly struggling artists like Picasso, Monet, and Renoir, Montmarte has retained its artistic charm and ambiance through the decades.
