




What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Italy

Day 2: Rome | Assisi

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.
- Travel to Assisi. Nestled on a hill between Mount Subasio and olive groves, the town of Assisi is visited by millions of people each year who wish to see outstanding examples of early Renaissance art and to appreciate its religious significance. During your visit, experience both aspects of this historical city at the Basilica of St. Francis, where Giotto's painted frescoes illustrate the life of one of Italy's most beloved saints. Here, the remains of St. Francis are entombed in a stone crypt above one of the altars. A local guide will show you the birthplace of St. Clare, who founded the Franciscan Order of Poor Ladies in the year 1212.

Day 3: Assisi | Florence

- Take an expertly guided tour of Assisi.
- Visit the Basilica of St. Francis.
- Travel to Florence, the birthplace of the Italian language, opera, and the Renaissance, and where works of art like Michelangelo's David and Botticelli's The Birth of Venus still reside today. As you stroll through the city, pass by classical statues at the Piazza della Signoria. See the domed cap of the Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral, better known as the Duomo, which dominates the skyline. Opposite the Duomo, look for the bronzed doors of Ghiberti's Gates of Paradise at the Baptistery. Walk across the Ponte Vecchio, a medieval bridge where many of Florence's famed leather and gold artisans keep shop.

Day 4: Florence

- Take an expertly guided tour of Florence and see the Piazza della Signoria, Ponte Vecchio, Chiesa di Santa Croce, Gates of Paradise, and Duomo.
- Visit the Accademia Gallery.

Day 5: Florence | Orvieto | Rome

- Travel to Orvieto, a charming Umbrian city perched on a hill. Take in the views of the surrounding countryside on a funicular ride.
- Continue on to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other. During your stay, explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the Roman Forum marks the former heart of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches there. On your visit to Vatican City, marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of Vatican City. Before you say "arrivederci," toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.

Day 6: Rome

- Take an expertly guided tour of Rome.
- Visit the Colosseum.
- Visit the Roman Forum.
- Take a self-guided walking tour of Rome and see the Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Piazza Navona, and Spanish Steps.

Day 7: Rome

- Take an expertly guided tour of Vatican City.
- Visit the Sistine Chapel.
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica.
- Enjoy time to see more of Rome or
- visit the Roman Catacombs.
- Enjoy a pizza dinner.

Day 8: Depart for home

Day 8: Rome | Caserta | Puglia region

- Travel to Puglia—a region packed with glittering coastlines, scenic hillside towns, and lots of olive oil—via Caserta.
- Enjoy guided sightseeing of the Royal Palace of Caserta with your Tour Director.

Day 9: Puglia region

- Take a food-themed guided tour of Bari.
- Travel to Polignano a Mare, a seaside town on the Adriatic Sea.

Day 10: Puglia region

- Travel to Alberobello.
- Discover Alberobello's famous trulli houses with an expert local guide.
- Visit a frantoio, where olives are made into delicious olive oil.

Day 11: Puglia region | Matera | Rome

- Stop in Matera on your way back to Rome
- Explore Matera on your own, and compare the ancient cave dwellings you see with the prehistoric building techniques of the trulli in Alberobello.

Day 12: Depart for home
