

Day 1: Fly overnight to Germany

Day 2: Berlin

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Berlin, the vibrant capital of reunified Germany. The city has been transformed since the Berlin Wall fell in 1989 and now plays a vital role in the European Union. Stroll past cafes, restaurants, and embassies along Unter den Linden, Berlin's most elegant boulevard.
- Take a walking tour of Berlin.

Day 3: Berlin

- Take an expert-led tour of Berlin: Brandenburg Gate.
- Have a photo stop at Checkpoint Charlie.
- Visit the Topography of Terror Museum, which was built on the grounds of the Gestapo and SS headquarters.
- Participate in a panel discussion about life during the Cold War.
- See Alexanderplatz.

Day 4: Berlin

- See the East Side Gallery.
- Visit the DDR Museum.
- Time to see more of Berlin or
 - explore Tiergarten by bike.

Day 5: Potsdam | Berlin

- Take a half-day excursion to Potsdam, where the postwar administration of Germany was decided at the 1945 Potsdam Conference.
 Potsdam was also the royal playground of Frederick the Great of Prussia.
- Visit one of Potsdam's Palaces.

Day 6: Berlin

- Take a walking tour of Kreuzberg District.
- Visit the Jewish Museum.
- Enjoy free time in Berlin or
- participate in a local exchange.

Day 7: Berlin

- Visit the Reichstag, the historical seat of Germany's parliament.
- See the Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe.

Day 8: Amsterdam
