What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Spain

Day 2: Málaga | Granada

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.
- Travel to Granada.

Day 3: Granada

- Take an expert-led tour of Granada.
- Compete in a “City Challenge” scavenger hunt.
- Visit the Alhambra, Granada’s crowning jewel that’s widely recognized as the world’s premier example of Moorish architecture. Built as an all-in-one *alcazaba* (fortress), *alcazar* (palace) and small *medina* (city), the Alhambra was home to the last of the Nasrid sultans. Elaborately embellished in the 14th century and surrounded by lush green trees, it was described by Moorish poets as “a pearl set in emeralds.” See the mosaics, fountains, latticed windows, arabesques, and ornamented courtyards that made this vast stronghold worthy of royal occupancy. (It’s also where King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella agreed to finance the historic voyage of Christopher Columbus.)
- Visit a Moroccan tea house.

Day 4: Granada | Seville

- Travel to Seville, city of flamenco dancing, Don Juan and *Carmen*, and the heartbeat of Andalusian culture.
- Visit an olive farm.
- Take a walking tour of Seville, where you’ll follow narrow, twisting alleys through the Barrio de Santa Cruz. See picturesque whitewashed houses, flower-filled patios, and tiled benches. Then pass by Maria Louisa Park to admire the mosaics and fountains of Plaza de España, the centerpiece of the 1929 Ibero-American Fair. You’ll also visit the Moorish Alcázar. Along the way, you’ll see the Giralda Tower, Torre del Oro, and Plaza de Toros.
- Visit the Setas de Seville.
- Free time to see more of Seville or [⚡ enjoy an evening river cruise](#).

Day 5: Seville

- Take an expert-led tour of Seville, Barrio de Santa Cruz.
- Visit the Seville Cathedral.
- Enjoy free time in Seville.
- Watch a flamenco show (which includes a flamenco lesson!).

Day 6: Córdoba | Madrid

- Travel to Córdoba, where you’ll see influences of the Moorish, Roman, Jewish, and Christian cultures that flourished here at different times in the city’s history.
- Visit the Mezquita, once a sacred Muslim site and the largest mosque west of Mecca.
- Continue on to Madrid.

Day 7: Madrid

- Take an expert-led tour of Madrid: Puerta del Sol; Plaza Mayor.
- Visit the Royal Palace.
- Enjoy an authentic Spanish lunch.
- Take a walking tour of Madrid.
- Visit the Prado.
- Enjoy a free evening to explore Madrid on your own.

Day 8: Madrid

- Free time to see more of Madrid or [⚡ participate in a cooking class](#).

Day 9: Madrid | Barcelona

- Travel by AVE train to Barcelona, an art lover’s dream city and the place where masters like Miró, Picasso, and Dalí flourished. During your stay you’ll explore open-air plazas dotted with avant-garde gems, like the Plaza de Catalunya and Plaza España.
- Take an expert-led tour Barcelona. Snap photos of the twisting spires of La Sagrada Família and the Magic Fountain of Montjuïc. From atop Montjuïc Hill, enjoy panoramic views of the harbor below. And check out the Gothic Quarter, which is the historic center of the old city of Barcelona.
- Marvel at the landscaped greenery and playful Modernist mosaics on your visit to Park Güell.

Day 10: Barcelona

- Take a walking tour of Barcelona. Flower vendors and street performers will greet you as you walk the tree-lined Las Ramblas.
- Time to see more of Barcelona or [⚡ see Barcelona by bike](#).

Day 11: Depart for home
